- Remember that you work as a team judging the rodeo, communicate with your partner and arena director or announcer and let them all know what call you made; foul, re-ride, re-run and etc... It will keep everyone on the same page and the rodeo will run smooth.
- Position is one of the most important aspects of judging any of the events. So please try to stay in position flagging or in the rough stock.
- Use the spread in the rough stock on the ride and the animal.
- Make your call and be confident with the calls you make, this is easy if you know your rulebook.
