The Superior Lions Club is a non-profit organization and the money generated from the rodeo and other activities is returned to the community in various ways.

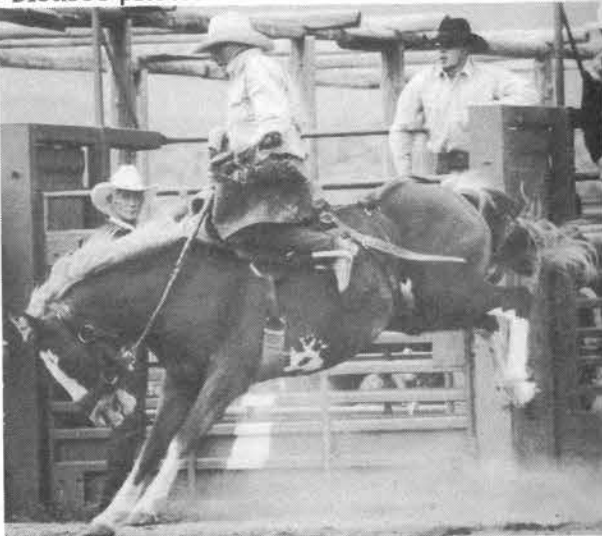
Voted the 1988 NRA Rodeo of the Year, the Superior Lions Club NRA rodeo welcomed nearly 300 contestants in 1997.

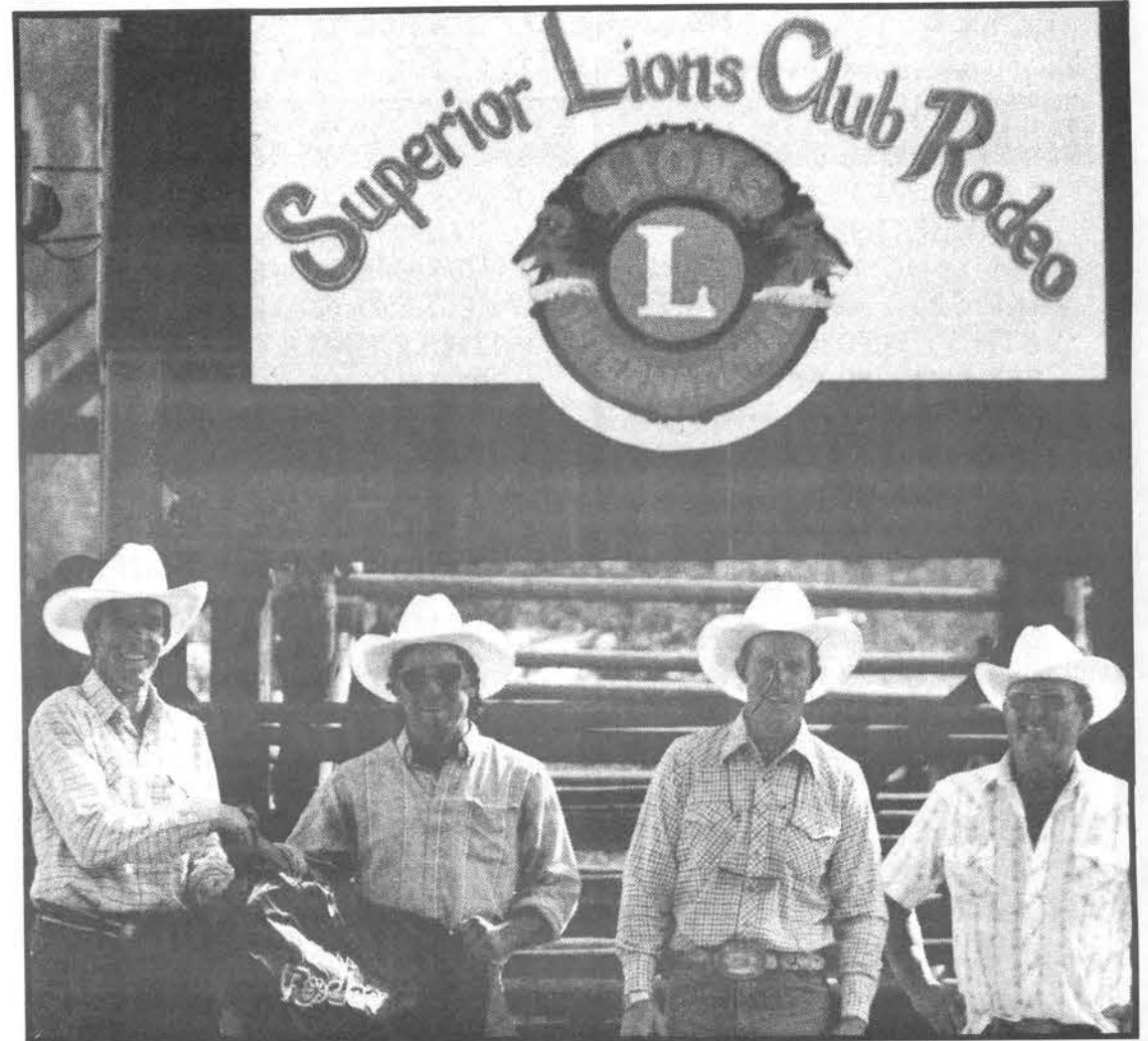

Montana takes the money at BFI! Winning third, fourth, and fifth at the prestigious Bob Feist Invitational Team Roping Classic, Montana cowboys took home over \$40,000 to the Treasure State.

1997 NRA Team Roping Champions, Sam Bird and Jim Cole, roped six steers in 53.6 to win second at the event in addition to \$23,776 in prizes and cash.

Guy Howell and Bobby Harris were fourth with a collective time of 54.12. The pair overcame a broken barrier in the first round and earned a \$2,000 cash bonus with the fastest time of the competition - 6.02 seconds - in the fourth go-around. They pocketed \$11,888 in prizes and cash.

Shane Schwenke and Kory Mytty placed fifth and earned \$6,604.

One of the most prestigious roping events in the world, the BFI was won by World Champions Speed Williams and Rich Skelton with a time of 52.01.

MEMBERSHIP: Entitles purchaser to work all sanctioned rodeos without restrictions, to share all advantages of a member in good standing including such items as a guarantee to your entry fee; check writing privileges after the first year initiation period; and a subscription to the newsletter.

PERMITS: Entitles purchaser to work all sanctioned rodeos accepting permits as listed in newsletter until \$500 is won. After \$500 money limit is won by permit holder, a card must be purchased, the price of card to be the dollar difference between the cost of a permit and the cost of the card. Permit holder's points will be credited to the year-end standing, however, the contestant must be a card holder to compete at the NRA Finals. The \$500 money limit will be accumulated from year to year, allowing the contestant to purchase a permit each year until the \$500 is won. A card holder the previous year cannot purchase a permit the following year.

RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE

In consideration of being allowed to participate in Northern Rodeo Association sanctioned events and membership in the Association, I and my heirs, successors, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE and agree to HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the Northern Rodeo Association, the rodeo committees, stock contractors, sponsors, arena operations or owners, their agents, representatives (collectively referred to as the NRA) from all liability me and my personal representatives, heirs, successors, and next of kin from any and all claims and liability for all loss of damage, and any claim of damages therefore on account of any injury to my person including death or damage to my property while I am utilizing NRA facilities or participating in NRA events.

I, hereby represent to the NRA that I understand that THERE ARE CERTAIN RISKS OF SERIOUS INJURY AND DEATH inherent in participating in rodeo events and any related activities. I realize conditions of the rodeo arena change from time to time and may become more hazardous, that rodeo animals are dangerous and unpredictable and there is INHERENT DANGER in rodeo which I appreciate and voluntarily assume because I choose to participate in such events. I make this choice even though I have observed or participated in events of this kind in the past and know conditions, facilities, rodeo animals, and other rodeo contestants and participants pose a danger to me. 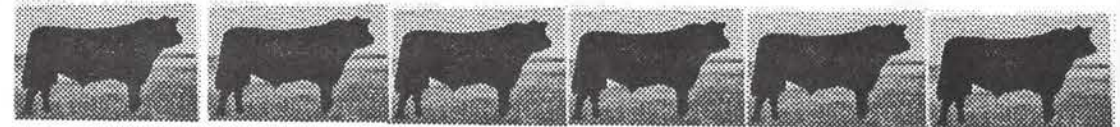

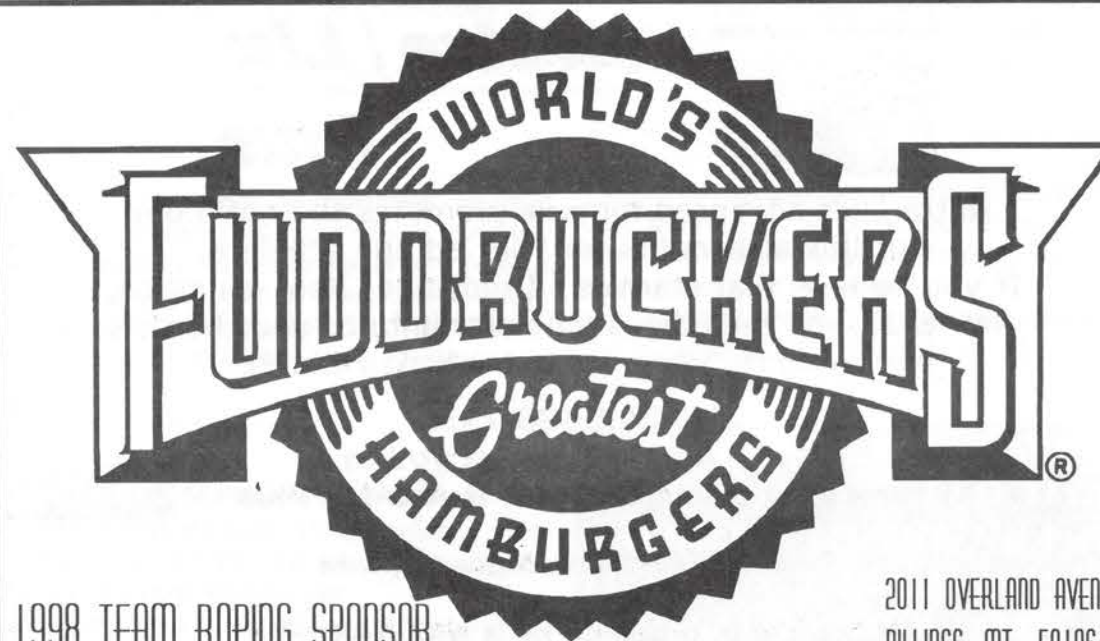

Drawouts, Tradeouts and Turnouts

The NRA Guidelines: for complete information, please refer to the NRA rulebook section A.8.0. The following is provided for your convenience.

DrawOuts: At the time of call back, a contestant may draw out of a rodeo(s). There is not a charge IF you did not receive your preference of performances. However, rule A.4.1.4 states: "Any contestant who draws out of a rodeo after receiving their first preference of performance at a given rodeo or rodeos will be fined \$20 per infraction."

TradeOuts: All NRA rodeos are trade-out rodeos unless advertised in the rodeo listing as "No Tradeouts".

A contestants may trade positions/performances of competition with another contestant at anytime after entries close, provided it is before the stock draw for that event.

If a trade is completed before callbacks close, trades are handled through centray entry and may continue to be handled up until 10 a.m. the day following callbacks.

After 10 a.m. the day after callbacks, all trades are handled through the NRA Office 406-252-1122. Both parties involved in a trade must call the NRA office and confirm the trade.

Trades can be made at the rodeo upon consent of both parties involved before the draw in that event. Both judges and rodeo secretary must be notified of trade by both parties. NOTE: The timed-event draw must be made in the presence of the rodeo secretary and can be made a minimum of two hours before the performance. We bring this to your attention so contestants plan to make trades earlier.

TurnOuts: As stated in the rulebook, if a contestant turns out at a rodeo, the fine will be equal to the entry fees. The NRA has rules which can soften the blow of an expensive turnout:

1. Notified turnout: If you know before 3 p.m. the last working day before the first performance of a ro-

deo that you will not be competing at this rodeo, call the NRA Office. You will be responsible for your entry fees plus a \$20 fine. The fine is \$20 (plus all entry fees) no matter how many events you are entered in.

2. If it is too late to notify the NRA Office, you can find someone who will pay your fees at the rodeo for you and notify the secretary, judges, and contractor that you will not be there, your fine is half your entry fee (plus the payment of your fees at the rodeo).

Courtesy, please. Contractors, judges, secretaries, spectators, announcers, and fellow contestants appreciate knowing if you will not be there, thus an animal will not be drawn and this eliminate unnecessary turnouts.

Medical and Vet Releases: As soon as you are aware that you will be unable to compete at an NRA rodeo you have entered due to a medical or vet release, contact the NRA office. With a medical or vet release you are not responsible for your fees but releases must be sent into the NRA office within five days after the rodeo along with a \$10 processing charge per rodeo.

Vet releases are accepted in the barrel racing event only. Keep in mind, when you medical or vet release, there is a five day waiting period before you can participate in another NRA rodeo.

How to enter NRA Rodeos

Welcome to the Northern Rodeo Association. NRA rodeos have utilized Big Sky Rodeo Central Entry since 1984 and offer the following guidelines to assist you. Take a moment to familiarize yourself with the NRA's rules on Central Entry. They can be found in section A.4.0 in the rulebook. A thorough knowledge of the NRA rules which apply to entering will help you better achieve your entry objective.

NRA Rodeo entry procedure through Big Sky Rodeo Central Entry • 406-428-2205

UNLESS OTHERWISE ADVERTISED, rodeo entries will open at 10 a.m. and remain open through 6:30 p.m. every Monday preceding a rodeo weekend. Call backs open at 12 Noon and remain open through 6:30 p.m. every Tuesday. Per rodeo charge of \$3.50 per contestant. Please read your rodeo listings carefully as the entry dates that fall on days other than the Monday before the rodeo will be in bold lettering.

When entering, be prepared with the following information for the central entry operator:

1. Name of rodeo(s) you wish to enter
2. Your NRA card number
3. Your name
4. The event (s) you wish to enter
5. Preferences you have on which performances you wish to work.
6. Name of buddy or buddies - NRA rules allow for two per event, six total.
(To buddy together you must enter together.)
7. If a multi-rodeo weekend, give information for each rodeo you wish to enter.
8. Call back Tuesday between 12 Noon and 6:30 p.m. (unless otherwise advertised) to find out when you are up.
9. Keep a record of the confirmation number the central entry operator gives you, both upon entering the rodeo, and when you call back. Every conversation, both entry and call back, is recorded on tape, and each person calling is given a verification number for that conversation.

In the event of a discrepancy, you **MUST** have your confirmation number available. No complaints against Central Entry will be considered valid unless a confirmation number is given.

If you do not call back during the specified call back times, late call backs will be accepted at the late call back number 406-428-2398. There is an additional charge of \$2.50 per rodeo for this service.

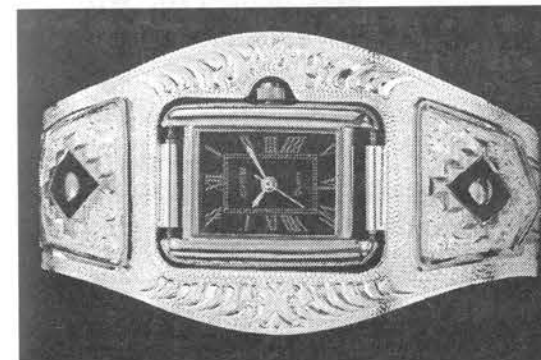




United State Bull Riding Championships

USBRC will consist of two divisions throughout the year and at the National Finals. Although most sanctioned events will still remain single purse events, only the standings will reflect the two divisions - Pro and semi-Pro. You may qualify for the Finals in one of two ways:

(1) The top 15 in each division in the year end standings will automatically go to the Finals.

(2) Each state will have a State Championship. The top two in each division will receive an automatic berth to the National finals. (Note: Only one entry at National Finals per member.)

Divisions: As stated above, USBRC will have two divisions. A Pro Division that will include anyone over \$2,000 lifetime in winnings, and a Semi-Pro Division, which will include everyone under \$2,000 lifetime. No exceptions, USBRC reserves the right to validate all membership forms.



Points for all sanctioned events in each Go and Average will be as follows:

1st Place - 10 points; 2nd Place - 8 points; 3rd Place - 6 points; 4th Place - 4 points; 5th Place - 2 points.

Points at the Finals in the Long Goes will be doubled. In the Short, they will be tripled. In order for your points to count at a sanctioned event, you must purchase your card prior to that event. Membership dues are \$45 for competing members. Our official newsletter is The Competitor News which is included in your membership.

Award for year-end winners in each division, Pro and Semi-Pro, will include saddles, buckles, bronze statues, jackets, protective vests, gear bags and various other prizes. There will also be awards for National Finals' winners as well. All awards will be given out at the convention that will be held in conjunction with the Finals.

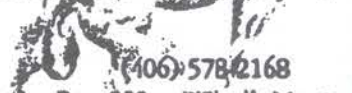
