## Hot news for farmers, ranchers flows on Northern Ag Network

5:50 a.m. The sun is gold on the eastern horizon and Taylor Brown is ready to start the day.

"Good Morning this is the Northern Ag Network..."

There follows in 12 radio program segments a tradition as new as today and as old as radio broadcasting - the farm report. From a dish near Laurel, Brown's ag news travels 23,000 miles in space to a satellite which sends it back to receiving radio stations.

A quarter second after the news leaves his studio above the Billings Livestock Commission it's heard in ranch kitchens and pickup truck cabs all over the northern Rockies.

Up-to-the-minute prices on cattle and grains is interspersed with ag weather reports, commodity updates and general agricultural news.

Later on the network switches to sports with relays of Denver Bronco and Colorado Rockies games. Next comes rodeo news, cowboy poetry, outdoor sports and more football and baseball.

Thousands of agricultural producers in Montana, Wyoming, Idaho and South Dakota tune their radios every day to one of the 23 radio stations who carry Brown's ag programs or 55 stations who carry the sports shows.

Asked why farmers and ranchers are

so intense an audience, Brown points to the way people are physically dispersed and sometimes isolated by their profession.

"And I think communications is critical because agriculture involves so many more dollars. There is a huge capital investment - so many millions at stake every day. And there is so much risk. So much changes every day," he said. "On any given day the weather, markets or government regulations may change your economic life."

To help the urban business person understand the aggie's need for news, Brown says they should think of a radio program about their own business.

"If you could listen to a program every day on the way to work that talked about events that affect your business, and that news was coming from somebody you know, somebody you see at your trade conventions - you would listen carefully, wouldn't you?"

Brown who owns the Northern Broadcasting System, and his associate Rick Haynes have as their mission "to provide a trusted, credible voice for agriculture."

Like their urban peers, farmers and ranchers are inundated with mountains of information, according to Brown. "A major focus of our efforts is to work through the mass of news and provide the listener a package of the most important information - just what you really need to know to start your day," Brown says.

Brown repeatedly emphasizes the importance of credibility. "We have to work hard to make sure we're dealing in the facts and not just our idea of the facts."



Their success is measured in their market penetration, Brown says. "You go out and ask farmers and ranchers to name the broadcasters they rely on the most and 83 percent of them will name Rick or myself."

Brown admits this gives him clout with the agriculture community; an attribute he tries to use with care. "We don't pretend to be objective journalists," he said. "We are admittedly strong advocates for agriculture."

That trait he shares with his mentor and predecessor, now U.S. Senator Conrad Burns.

"Conrad started the network in 1975. He hired me in 1979," Brown said. "I was a year out of college and looking around for something other than going back to the ranch. I talked to Conrad and he just put me to work."

"Then he got into politics, and it's just impossible to be in politics and broadcasting at the same time so he sold me the network," Brown said.

Brown comes by his ranching allegiance honestly. His great grandfather came to Montana from Texas with the great trail drives of the 19th century. The family finally settled on a ranch near Sand Springs in 1960 which his father still runs.

"I still like to go back to the ranch," Brown says. "But now that I own the network I don't have time to do any actual ranching." His only regret of coming to the city to live seems to be that he and his wife Shannon can't raise their three young children out on the prairie.

But no regrets shade his obvious enthusiasm for the broadcasting business. "We have committed to customer service in this business like nobody else has," he says. "We know we really have to make it work for the affiliate sta-

tions and we bend over backwards to help them and to help the sponsors."

Northern Ag Network doesn't just sell ad spots to sponsors, Brown says. Just like with his listener customers he sees credibility as his stock in trade. "We operate with a philosophy of relationship marketing. We do our best to promote our sponsors' business and we take their welfare to heart."

In that spirit, Brown and his staff celebrated the network's 20th anniversary by traveling in a motor home to each of their 55 affiliate stations during a two-week span.

"We spent at least an hour at each station. It turned out to be quite an undertaking," Brown said.

But the feedback we got from sponsors and listeners was invaluable. We learned, for instance, that we have dry bean growers in the Big Horn Valley who need information and we learned that sheep growers can't get timely wool prices in the shearing season. You can't get ideas for improving your service like that if you're not out there talking to people."

Brown has earned a long string of broadcasting awards. He is proudest, perhaps of being elected the 1992 President of the National Association of Farm Broadcasters. "I guess I'm proud that we have achieved the presence in the national industry from here in Billings for me to be association president."
