


The 26th Annual NRA/NWRA Finals will be held February 2 - 4, 2001.



In Memory of Charlie Pierce

The Northern Rodeo Association/Northern Women's Rodeo Association is deeply saddened by the loss of one of the best cowboys and dedicated committee men in the association, Charlie Pierce.

Charlie Pierce passed away Thursday, July 20, at his home of natural causes.

Charlie had been an active member of the Meagher County Rodeo Club since 1985 after moving to White Sulpher Springs. He never held any office within the club, but he was active in helping with the construction of the calf chutes on the south end, the arena fence, and the rough stock pens behind the bucking chutes.

The rodeo were grounds

Charlie's second home from May 1st to October 1st each year.

When the rodeo stock arrived on the grounds, Charlie and Ben Heriem were the "Official" caretakers. He fed the rodeo stock, watered and worked the ground for all events throughout the year. As quoted by Willard Bernhardt, "Charlie was the most dependable tractor man we ever had, I don't know where we'll find another one."


Every Labor Day, Charlie could be found with his hearty laugh and smile running the small gate at the north end to let the rough stock contestants in and out. He was supportive in the calcutta held during

the rodeo. Charlie was also active in all the kids' events held here, either helping set up or maybe helping judge an event.

A celebration of Charlie's life was held at the Meagher County Rodeo grounds in White Sulpher Springs Wednesday, July 26th. Many, many people turned out to celebrate Charlie's life at his second home, the Meagher Rodeo County grounds.

Charlie gave so much to the Rodeo Club and never asked for anything in return. He will be greatly missed by all.

Memorials can be made to the Charlie Pierce Memorial Fund at First National Bank, P.O. box 709, White Sulpher Springs, MT. 59645, which will be used to help purchase a sound system for the high school gymnasium.



MEMBERSHIP: Entiltles purchaser to work all sanctioned rodeos without restrictions, to share all advantages of a member in good standing including such items as a guarantee to your entry fee; check writing privileges after the first year initiation period; and a subscription to the newsletter.

PERMITS: Entitles purchaser to work all sanctioned rodeos accepting permits as listed in newsletter until \$500 is won. After \$500 money limit is won by permit holder, a card must be purchased, the price of card to be the dollar difference between the cost of a permit and the cost of the card. Permit holder's points will be credited to the year-end standing, however, the contestant must be a card holder to compete at the NRA Finals. The \$500 money limit will be accumulated from year to year, allowing the contestant to purchase a permit each year until the \$500 is won. A card holder the previous year cannot purchase a permit the following year.

RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE

In consideration of being allowed to participate in Northern Rodeo Association sanctioned events and membership in the Association,I and my heirs, successors, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE and agree to HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the Northern Rodeo Association, the rodeo committees, stock contractors, sponsors, arena operations or owners, their agents, representatives (collectively referred to as the NRA) from all liability me and my personal representatives, heirs, successors, and next of kin from any and all claims and liability for all loss of damage, and any claim of damages therefore on account of any injury to my person including death or damage to my property while I am utilizing NRA facilities or participating in NRA events.

I, hereby represent to the NRA that I understand that THERE ARE CERTAIN RISKS OF SERIOUS INJURY AND DEATH inherent in participating in rodeo events and any related activities. I realize conditions of the rodeo arena change from time to time and may become more hazardous, that rodeo animals are dangerous and unpredictable and there is INHERENT DANGER in rodeo which I appreciate and voluntarily assume because I choose to participate in such events. I make this choice even though I have observed or participated in events of this kind in the past and know conditions, facilities, rodeo animals, and other rodeo contestants and participants pose a danger to me. I recognize and expressly agree to assume the entire risk of any and all accidents or personal injury including serious paralysis or death which I might suffer during my participation in said events.

I further COVENANT AND AGREE NOT TO SUE THE NRA for any injury, damages or death which occur as a result of my participation in said events and any claim or damage therefore. I understand that this document may be treated as a complete defense to any legal action I might bring against the NRA for any injuries or other damages I might suffer.

I understand and agree this RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE extends to any and all claims I may have, specially including, but not limited to, claims arising out of participation in said events, claims with respect to the design, manufacture, repair, or maintenance of facilities or equipment which I will be using, or with respect to the conditions, qualification, instructions, rules or procedures under which my use of said facilities or equipment are conducted or from any other cause.
