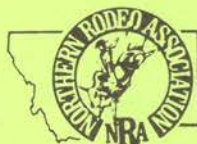

From the Crow's Nest



It was the best of times and the worst of times.

The Northern Rodeo Association had experienced what President Glen Hough termed a "banner year" with record amounts of prize money being paid out to record numbers of competitors.

The association was gearing up for its annual year-end finals rodeo, the time when championships would be determined and prizes awarded. Scheduled annually for the past 16 years during the first weekend of February at the Metra in Billings, rodeo fans and contestants alike traditionally plan their winters to include a weekend in Billings at the Finals.

Mother Nature was determined to change everyone's minds.

An arctic cold front from Alaska, with 40-below temperatures swept into Montana, Tuesday, Jan. 31 bringing heavy snow and blizzard-like conditions.

Would there be a rodeo?

There was.

Conditions were not as pleasant as in some winters when the weather was mild, but the rodeo went on in true western tradition.

Everyone cooperated and tried to make things as easy as possible, and although crowds were about half of what they usually are, their enthusiasm was not dampened and much cheering and "ya-hooing" warmed up the inside of the Metra. There were, of course, a number of competitors who were unable to shovel out of the snow, or start vehicles, or were unwilling to leave home

in the arctic-like temperatures, so in several events substitutes were called in to fill in where the finalists were unable to compete.

After 10 years of mild winters, Montana finally got what old timers call "winter," and it did, indeed, have a big impact on the NRA's biggest money-maker of the year. Final tabulations will be made available to the membership soon.

All the other events scheduled during the Finals weekend went on as usual, including the Past Presidents breakfast, the cocktail party with the cowboy auction, the junior events on Saturday morning, and all the meetings. The break-in jackpot on Thursday was cancelled, however.

During the board of directors meeting on Saturday afternoon, Becky Tescher was selected to be the editor of the NRA News. This selection was made after much discussion, several votes, and much soul-searching.

She plans to continue the publication much as it is, however, mailing it from Billings. She has high qualifications, a lifetime background in rodeo plus a degree in journalism, and a job as managing editor of the Agri-News under publisher Pat Gogins.

You will find out more about her in the years to come.

We promise that this is our last issue. We agreed to edit this Finals issue to smooth out the transition between the two editors, but our 10 years of being at the helm of the official publication is officially over.

It has been the best of times and the worst of times.

Please remember that although we won't be "putting out" the newsletter, our involvement in rodeo will still continue. Knowing how little

input an editor can get from the membership into the newsletter, we may even have an occasional letter to the editor in the new publication.

Please support the new editor. Send in news, advertising, and little tid-bits of information, like marriages, births, deaths, etc. The newsletter is read (yes, we did find that out) by over 1,200 people, not only in Montana, but across the United States, so it can be a vital link in disseminating information. Use it. As a member, you pay for it. As a member, it is your responsibility to support it.

Our "cowboy stories" will continue to be heard at rodeo arenas across the state.

Other new faces on the board include Phil Fleming as team roping director, Patti Holland as junior events director and Joe Murnion of Jordan as one of the East Committee directors.

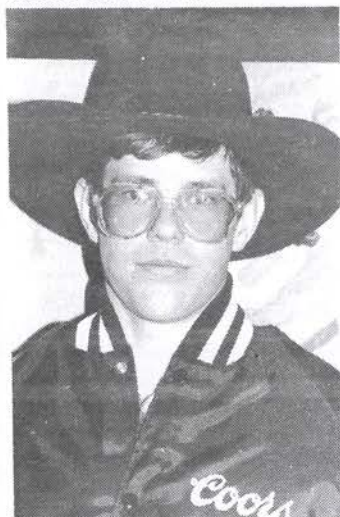


Mortensen, Cross Each Win Two Saddles

Mary Melaney-Salmond and two Dans — Dan Mortensen and Dan Cross — had dandy weekends at the Northern Rodeo Association Championship Finals held in Billings, Feb. 3-5.

Mortensen of Billings and Cross of Cody, each competed well enough to own two year end trophy saddles at the conclusion of the finals.

Mortensen came to the finals with a \$900 lead in NRA bull riding competition. "I just had to make one good ride," to secure the year end championship, the former high school champion said. He did that on Saturday evening scoring 79 on "Charlie Pride," a Jacob's Livestock bull voted by bull riders as the best bull at the finals.

But it was the saddle bronc riding title that Mortensen coveted. He trailed former two-time saddle bronc riding champion Jim Walker, Lovell, by \$9 coming into the finals. Mortensen, whose goal was to make it in the top 10 in the saddle bronc riding, left nothing to chance.

He split first the saddle bronc riding first go and won

the next two, easily winning the average and almost \$1,500.

In this event, Mortenson again rode the cowboy's choice. He marked 75 points on Jacobs "Shelby Downs," voted saddle bronc horse of the finals by the bronc riders.

Cody's Danny Cross showed off the trait that brought him to finals, cool consistency. He roped all three calves without a hitch, winning second in the average and taking the year end awards from the leader going into the finals, Bryan Anderson, Marana, Ariz. Cross, second in the steer wrestling at the start of the finals gained on Spike Guardipee of Browning throughout the rodeo. When it was said and done, Cross' fourth place finish in the average gave him a \$58 year end lead and the title.

Mary Salmond pocketed the most money at the finals. The standout Choteau cowgirl won the average in both the breakaway roping and the barrel racing and picked up a placing in the team roping and

fetched \$2,592.50 for her weekend's work.

Kevin Kessler, a last minute fill-in for an injured Bob Schall and snowed-in Scott Schall and Slim Lemmon, rode three horses to win the finals bare-back riding average. Steve Cutler of Lewistown had the year end award won before the Finals ever started.



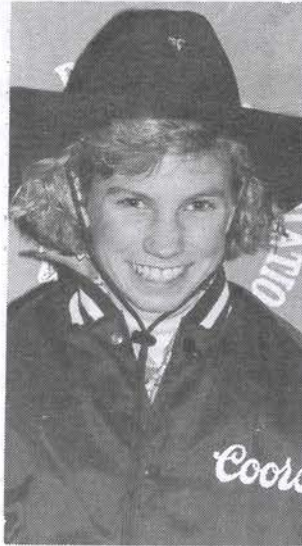

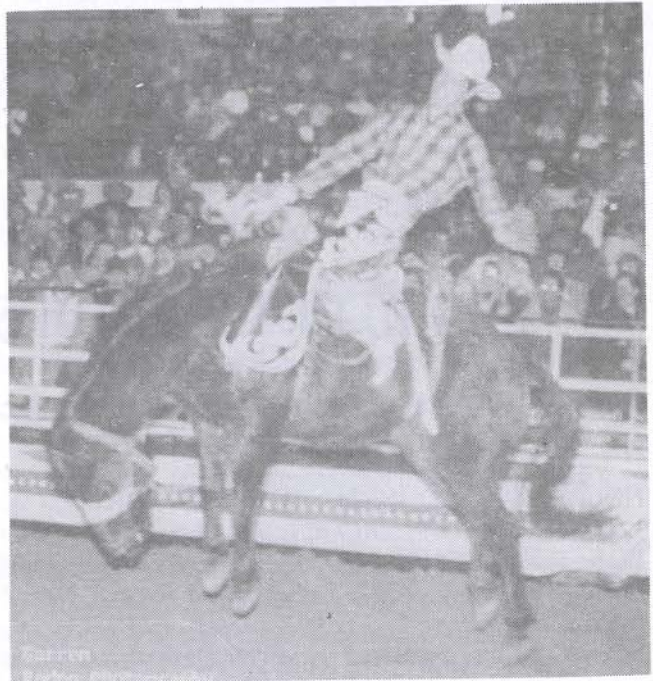

Glen Hough moved: The NRA maintain own newsletter and purchase outside advertising. Butch Bratsky, seconded. Discussion. DEFEATED. Don Jacobs moved: The NRA accept the proposal of the Cowboy's Digest. Phil Fleming, seconded. DEFEATED.

Ed Miller moved: to reconsider Glen's motion and bring it back on the floor. Jim Bushnell seconded. PASSED. Becky Tescher will be the NRA News editor and her proposal accepted. The NRA will continue to purchase outside advertising.

Feb. 14, weighing in at 5 pounds. Congratulations!

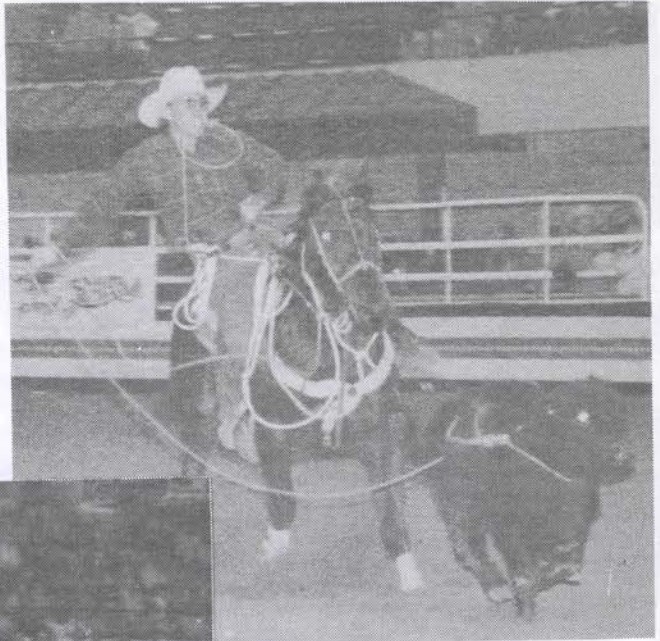
Mr. and Mrs. Vaughn Thurston of Great Falls are also the parents of a new baby boy, but no information is available on name, date, weight, etc.

The price of said card to be the dollar difference between the cost of a permit and the cost of the card. Permit holder's points will be credited to the year end standings, however, the contestant must be a card holder to compete at the NRA Finals Rodeo. The \$500 money limit will be accumulated from year to year, allowing the contestant to purchase a permit each year until the \$500 is won. A card holder the previous year CANNOT purchase a permit the following year.
