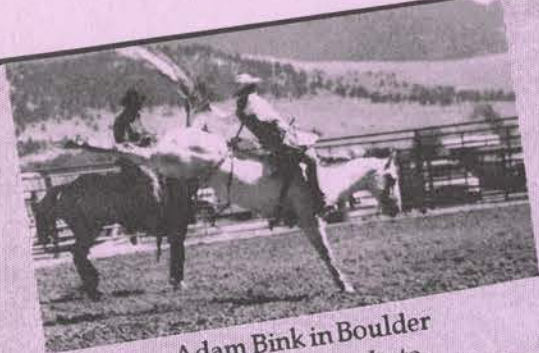

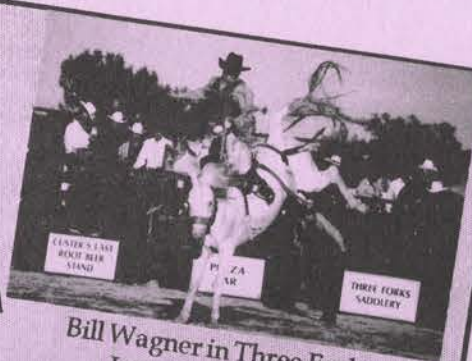

Office Updates

Congratulations, top 10!

You have qualified for a spot at the 24th annual Northern Rodeo Finals!

With 36 approved rodeos this season produced by 5 NRA approved stock contractors, the stats are quite impressive.

Every event leader has over \$4,000 won, with the top five in the All-Around cowboy standings having won over \$5,000 apiece and a slim \$900 separating number one from number five.

Dawn Odom sets the money won pace with \$8,062 won in one event - the barrel racing, while over 16 saddle bronc riders collected at least \$1,000 in earnings along with 24 bull riders and calf ropers, 22 steer wrestlers, 18 breakaways and 30 team ropers that passed the \$1,000 mark.

In the bareback riding, 31 different cowboys won a check compared with 22 last year. 31 Saddle bronc riders took home a paycheck compared with 29 last year. Bull riders abound with 87 toro twisters cashing a paycheck, that's three more than in 1997. Rodeo team ropers increased too, with 133 winning money this year and an increase of 9 over last year. Paycheck earning steer wrestlers are increasing, too, with 64 money winners in 1998 versus 57 in 1997. Calf ropers declined four, with 58 money winners compared to 62 last year. In the ladies events, there is a slight decline with 47 check cashing barrel racers this year and 51 in 1997, while the breakaway ropers had 51 go to the pay window this year compared to 56 a year ago.

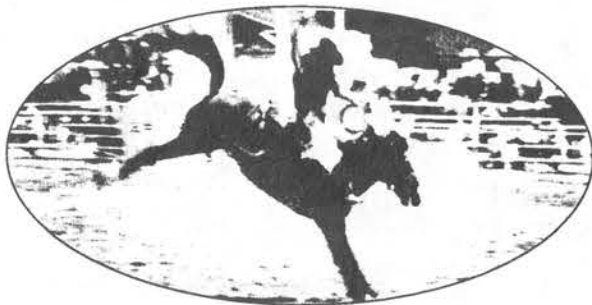

On July 16 Brent, age 29, son, husband, and father died in a floating accident on the Yellowstone River.

Brent was born to Gerald and Margaret Ryder on July 7, 1969 in Billings, Montana, residing in several National Parks while growing up. He graduated from Cardston High School in Alberta, Canada in 1989.

Brent attended Blue Mountain Community College in Pendleton, Oregon, on a rodeo scholarship, earning a liberal arts degree in 1990.

Brent and Tricia Quaempts were married on April 13, 1996 in Bozeman, MT. They had two children, Wynston, age 2, and Alexis, 4 months.

Brent pursued a career in Real Estate, establishing his own company R & Q Enterprises. IN addition, Brent was multi-faceted and took on the responsibility of managing the Dome Mountain Ranch in Paradise Valley, where he was also a licensed outfitter.

Rodeo was a life long passion for Brent.

He enjoyed many accomplishments including champion header of the Northwest Region in College, 1995 NRA All-Around Cowboy and 1995 NRA Champion Steer Wrestler. Brent also earned many titles in team roping. He will be missed in the arena not only because of his talent but also because of his strong character and humor. His other passions included family, hunting, his career and horses.

Brent is survived by his wife Tricia, two children Wynston and Alexis; parents Gerald and Margaret of Yellowstone Park; grandparents Earl and Carol Johnson of Roundup and Betty Ryder of Billings; and many aunts, uncles, cousins, nephew and nieces. He was preceded in death by his only sibling, his brother John Ryder, and his grandfather Carl Ryder.

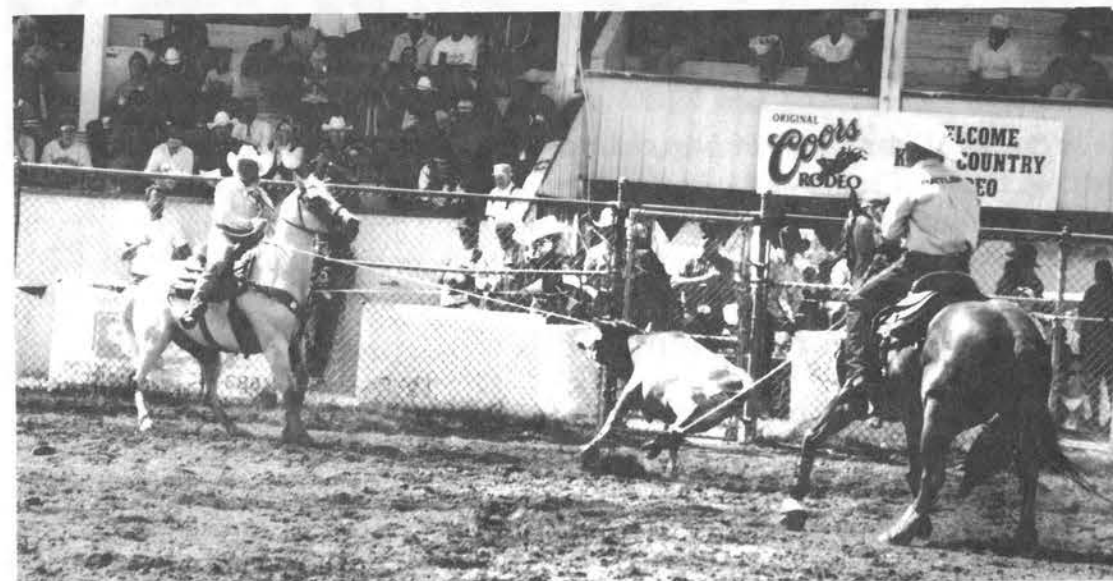

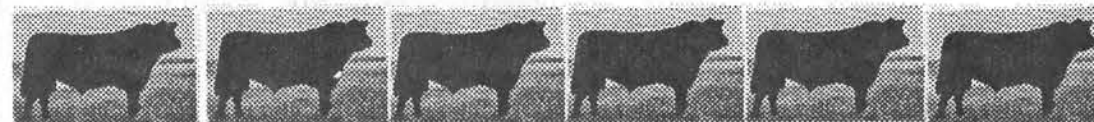

Where are they Now?

This is the third in a series of past champions (call them heros or legends if you want). A touch of some of the past success and history of rodeo sometimes gets forgotten in today's rodeo world. In many cases, the people who competed in the past set the pace for what rodeo is today. Meet Elmer Nettleton.

A founding father: Helena Valley bulldogging bunch

Most NRA members today probably were not even born the summer that Elmer Nettleton won the 1964 NCMRA Steer Wrestling Championship.

And 35 years later, Elmer is continues to compete; and, if it were not for the hard ground, he would still rather be bulldogging!

"I had fooled around with a rope all of my life, but I had never worked at

it," says Nettleton. "George Eichhorn and his son and I worked real hard at roping and tying all one winter."

It paid off. Elmer won the Canadian Senior Pro calf roping title two years in a row and the Canadian Senior Pro Team roping championship three consecutive years.

Elmer and Ruth were married in September of 1951. Presently, they are rodeoing in the Senior Pro Circuit; Elmer is currently ranked number two in the

team roping. They won the Senior Pro Ribbon Roping Championship in 1993 and were reserve champions in 1994 and 1995.

Elmer Nettleton of Helena, besides being one awfully nice guy, could probably be given credit as one of the founding fathers of the Helena Valley bull doggin' motley bunch that is still turf-en-em

in the dirt today.

Elmer, Don Blixt, Dick Kelley, crusty Jim Harris, Pal Palmer, and Walt Holland, were the originators of this group.

Elmer is always well mounted; his horses always perform. With the exception of one horse that he bought from Fred Berzel, he raised and trained all of them. He does things right; he wouldn't want his friends to call him a perfectionist, but he is one and a true legend of rodeo.

Sharon Martin: It's not her first rodeo!

For those of you relatively new on the Northern Rodeo Association scene, she was there *before* Dale Small!

Sharon Martin began her NRA rodeo secretary career with Horace Raty Rodeo Company of Square Butte and then joined the outfit owned by Ralph Cunningham of Billings. Cunningham once owned and operated Billings Livestock Commission Company (BLS). Eventually, Dale Small bought Ralph out and the Small Rodeo Company began.

Sharon continued to secretary rodeos for Small Rodeo Company, taking only a four-five year break in the 1970's to haul her kids, Bruce and Brenda, to High School and Junior rodeos.

Sharon resumed her rodeo secretary duties again and secretaried for Small Rodeo Company until 1986.

Rodeos -and secretarying one- were alot different *then* than what we have grown accustomed to in today's demanding rodeo world.

And Sharon's experience runs deep. Like way before the inception of central entry for rodeos.

The way we were -

And not that long ago - try 1983...The day that entries were taken for each individual rodeo, the actual rodeo secretary would travel to the specific rodeo town and actually answer the one-line telephone and take the entries. Entries might be taken at the fair office, or a local cafe or bar. Contestants could spend hours trying

to get through on the one-line using their dial telephones!

The secretary would set up the ro-

deo (all by hand), and usually the next day would be set for callbacks.

If you did not get called back, it was rough going, as the only person with a rodeo program was the secretary...and maybe the committee! There were no fax machines, no central entry, no NRA office that had a copy of the program, and no continuity between the rodeos. The rodeo entry dates did not coincide, there was not communication between the rodeos, so you were pretty much out there on your own!

The rodeo secretary was out there from the day of entries until the last bull riding check was written, sometimes staying in the particular town throughtout the entire week.

Sharon's secretary travels took her to many places. In Wyoming: Riverton, Buffalo, Basin, Worland, Lovell; in Montana: Billings, Jordan, Circle, Richey, Lambert, Glasgow, Dodson, Fort Benton, Roy, Winnett, Winifred, Chinook, Miles City,

When the NRA had thoughts of a central entry system, Sharon had been there as a rodeo secretary and knew what it took to take the entries and put a rodeo together.

Hamilton, Forsyth, White Sulphur, Havre, Lewistown, Shelby, Red Lodge, Bridger, Belfry, Plains, Geraldine, and most every rodeo town in Montana.

When the NRA had thoughts of a central entry system, Sharon had been there as a rodeo secretary and knew what it took to take the entries and put a rodeo together.

In addition, Sharon did her time as Association secretary for the NCMRA, the predecessor to the NRA, for three years she managed the office and put together the Association's newsletter. Many times the rodeo secretary would wind up timing the

rodeo, too. Sharon did her share.

In 1984, Big Sky Rodeo Central Entry was born and the NRA signed on.

With the support of her family, and computer programming son-in-law Paul Descheemaeker, the first entry program was written.

1998 marks the 15th year of Big Sky Rodeo Central Entry's service to the NRA.

It also marks BSRCE's 7th year of providing entry and callbacks for the National Senior Pro Rodeo Association.

Since 1971 Clint and Sharon Martin have made their home near Grass Range where they ranch and Clint competes in NSPRA rodeos.

Their son and daughter-in-law, Bruce and Becky Martin ranch nearby. Both are involved with NRA rodeo. Bruce, a many-time NRA finalist in the bareback riding, now is a level one judge, and Becky is active as a rodeo secretary.

Daughter Brenda and husband Paul Descheemaeker also ranch nearby.

Life is never dull on the Martin ranch where their seven grandkids keep things hopping!

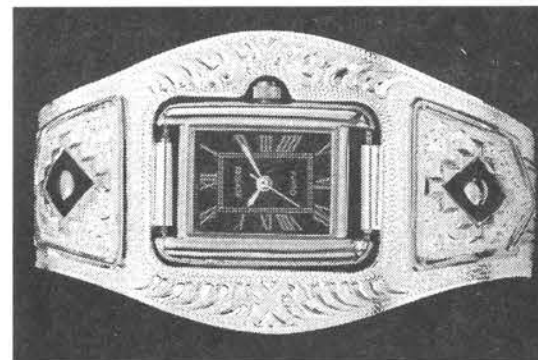

Darby barrel racer Odom has world by tail

With a tip of her white hat to Lisa Scheffer, and a nudge of the heels to Smoky, a just-turned 15 barrel racer from Darby is having the summer of her life.

Dawn Odom will rest today. "It'll be the first time we make it to church since Easter", her mom, Melissa, confessed Saturday night at the first performance of the Arlee Rodeo.

The Odoms have to wait until Monday to find out how Dawn ultimately fared at Northern Rodeo Association contests in Three Forks, Shelby and Arlee. When she left them on Friday and Saturday, she was leading all three.

Her time of 16.08 seconds atop 14 yr. old

Smoky in a heavy arena at Arlee was more than two-tenths of a second faster than that of hometown favorite Rachael Myllymaki, who can identify with child prodigies. Myllymaki was just 11 when she first qualified for the National Finals Rodeo a decade ago. First place has become a comfortable position for the poised, pony-tailed Odom. In her first serious summer on the NRA circuit, she has opened a gaping lead in the standings. She overhauled her coach and mentor, Scheffer, over the Fourth of July.

Odom is still young enough to compete in NRA's junior barrel racing, which requires a contestant to be no older than 14 on Jan. 1 Normally she hops on her 21-year-old

war horse, Bugsy, for junior barrels and well, doesn't win. At Arlee, Bugsy was too tired and the evening was too hot. Odom borrowed a mount from friend Chantelle Bainbridge and ran a 16.32. It was the second-fastest time of the day, junior barrels or otherwise.

"I love barrel racing. It's my passion, my love. It's everything," said Odom.

"I love barrel racing. It's my passion, my love. It's everything," said Odom, a straight-A home schooled student who'll enter ninth grade in the fall.

"It's an adrenaline

rush and you really have to ride."

She's had plenty of help living her love. Her calf-roping dad, Don, bought Smoky three years ago in Oklahoma. Smoky, said Dawn, was an "awesome" cutting and roping horse once winning \$25,000 in a three-week stretch. By gentle persuasion or otherwise, Dawn and Melissa talked Don into letting Smoky chase barrels instead of bovines.

The bay gelding wasn't an overnight sensation.

In their first timed cloverleaf pattern together, Dawn and Smoky ran a pokey 26 seconds at an O-Mok-See in Missoula.

"I gave up on him a couple of times," Dawn admitted.

But Melissa never did. And when she

hooked Dawn up with Scheffer, a former national collegiate champion and U of M rodeo coach, it quickly became apparent Smoky and Dawn bore the marks or winners.

They ran mostly at Little Britches rodeos last year, qualifying for nationals at Colorado in several events. Another milestone from 1997: Odom and Smoky beat world champion Christie Peterson at a jackpot competition in Colorado.

Odom's first NRA season has turned out better than she dared hope. Included so far are wins at two of the circuit's better rodeos, Roundup and Harlowton, on the same weekend. This weekend could top even that feat.

Odom, who turned 15 on July 6, had a couple of other milestones this week: She got her driver's license (soon to come: personalized plates that read "HOLDAWN") and she received her Canadian Pro Rodeo Association card.

She and Smoky will probably start racing

north of the border in August.

"She's paid her dues," maintained Melissa Odom, who said she has miles of videotape on Dawn's practice and performance runs to prove it. "Mom" Odom is also a seamstress and she has put herself in charge of Dawn's barrel racing ensembles. On Saturday, Dawn wore pants that were black and lime green ("it's my favorite color", she said of the latter) and Smoky wore a matching lime saddle blanket. Other color combinations are available for other shows.

There is some sense of urgency for Dawn to make her mark on pro rodeo, since Smoky is probably nearing the end of his barrel-racing prime. On the other hand, he just entered it, thanks to the gift of a father, the faith or a mom, the tutelage of an accomplished barrel racer like Scheffer - and Dawn.

By all indications, her success is not tied to the talent of one horse. Could be there'll be a lot more summers of fun and fast barrel runs for Dawn Odom.

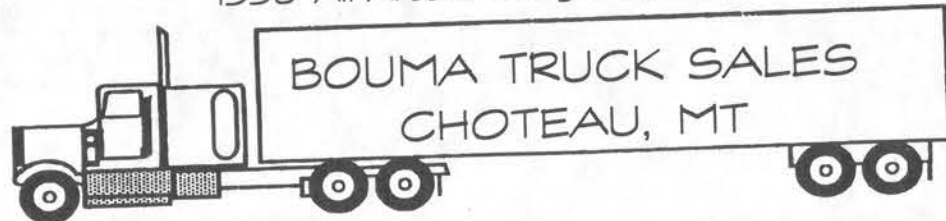
