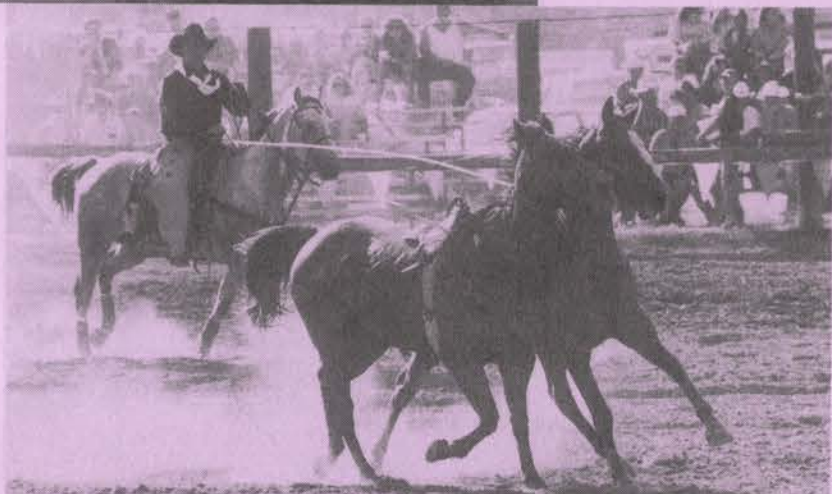

NRA season closes on upswing

With the close of the NRA's busy summer rodeo season, the NRA had sanctioned 38 rodeos with a total of 76 performances which played host to 10,246 contestants.

Overall, the 1996 NRA rodeo season is the second best on record.

With 1,242 members, the following reflects the event and the number of contestants who earned a paycheck in that particular event during the past rodeo season: Bareback Riding: 31; Saddle Bronc Riding: 39; Bull Riding: 103; Steer Wrestling: 65; Calf Roping: 64; Team Roping: 159; Ladies Barrel Racing: 46; Ladies Breakaway Roping: 47; Junior Barrels: 37; Junior Breakaway: 38.

In all, over 600 individual members collected a paycheck at an NRA event this summer. That's 50% of the membership.

The top ten money winners in each event qualify for the 23rd annual Northern Rodeo Finals Jan. 31-Feb. 2, 1997 at the METRAPARK Arena.

This year's NRF will sport a whole new look as the NRA welcomes David Allen and Associates as the Finals manager/promoter.

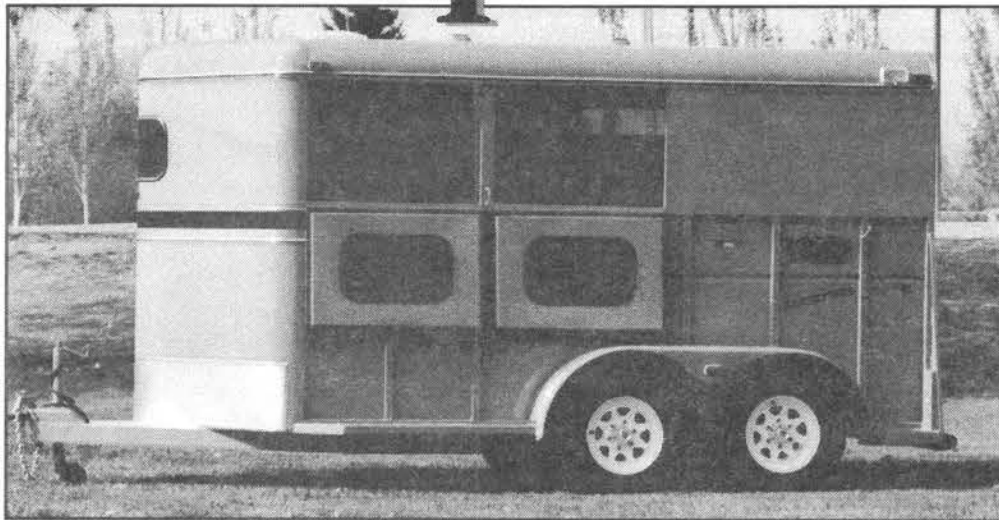

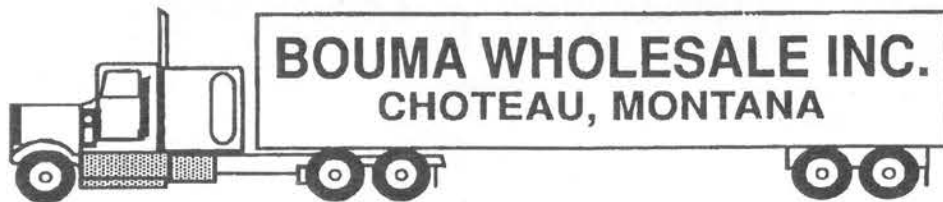

Old Three Forks arena has seen its last rodeo

The last bronc bucked at the Three Forks rodeo arena, a nearly 50-year-old structure that has fallen victim to the encroachment of lawns and houses.

After faithfully serving since 1947, the arena is being replaced with a new arena near the Jefferson River. The city's 50th annual rodeo over the weekend marked the old arena's final display.

When it was built, the arena was on the edge of town. But neighborhoods crept around it over the years. Where once there was plenty of room for horses and livestock to maneuver, now there are lawns and shrubbery, said City Councilman Rob Norman.

"Its gotten to be a safety issue," Norman said.

The city owns 23 acres near the river. Placing the new arena there will avoid conflicts between homeowners and the rodeo's hoofed participants.

It also gives Three Forks an opportunity to create a multipurpose arena with a riverside park, space for car shows and swap meets and a few building's for indoor events, Norman said.

"I think it is something the city of Three Forks can build and the whole valley can benefit from," Norman said.

The riverside arena and grounds will be financed by selling the land on which the old arena sits. Three Forks is going to clean the

place up before it goes on the market. "We're afraid if we sell it in the condition it is, it will remain that way," Norman said.

Norman couldn't put a price tag on the new project. He's hoping the community will pitch in with materials and labor, much like it did in 1947 when the first arena was built.

That project was headed by Fred Hafner, who had just returned from World War II. Now retired and living in Manhattan, Hafner said Three Forks residents were asked to either work a day on the project or donate \$6 to the cause - a day's wages in 1947.

Montana Power Co. hooked up the lights for free.

The Soil Conservation Service donated a post hole digger and a rancher let rodeo organizers cut timber from his land near Pony to build the arena, Hafner said.

The entire project was done in two months. Parts of the arena were finished the day the first rodeo was to begin, he said.

Sheridan College gets new rodeo Coach

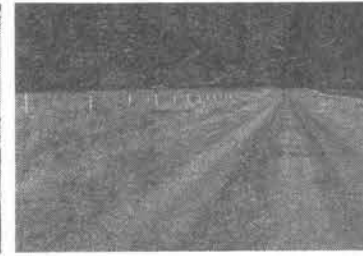

Justin Davis, 24, of Bozeman, Montana is the new rodeo coach at Sheridan College. Davis served as the National Student President of the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association in 1995-96 and as regional director for the Big Sky Region NIRA from 1994-96. He also served an internship as assistant rodeo coach at MSU-Bozeman. A top competitor, Davis was first in the Big Sky Region in the steer wrestling in 1996 and went on to finish second in the College National Finals in his event. In addition to his involvement with rodeo, Davis's sports experience includes serving as a professional ski instructor at Bridger Bowl and

refereeing intramural basketball games at MSU.

Davis received his bachelor of science degree in health education from MSU this year and plans to put his degree to work at SC in the form of an event specific weight training program for SC rodeo athletes. Other plans for the year include scheduling as much practice time as possible for the team along with holding regular "study tables" to help team members succeed academically. Davis says his goal is to return to the National Finals Rodeo, this time as the coach of a top ranked SC rodeo team. His immediate task is to prepare for the 6th annual Sheridan College Pat Hamilton Memorial Rodeo which will be held September 20-22 at the Sheridan County Fairgrounds.

Davis is originally from Sidney, Montana and is the son of Bill Davis, known to many in this area for his achievements in bull dogging and calf roping competition.

FACES CHANGE, BUT SCHEFFER'S SKILLS STILL SHARP

Lisa Scheffer is not old. A daily check in the mirror, her birth certificate and driver's license attest to that fact.

However, when walking around the rodeo arena, Scheffer feels slightly different.

"There's a lot of new faces," Scheffer said. "Somebody will walk up and say 'Hi,' and I have to ask, 'Who is that?' When I'm told, my gosh, I knew some of those kids when they were five and six years old.

"I used to see some of those kids in diapers and now they're beating me ... and that's bad."

Scheffer finished the last sentence with a good laugh.

No, she's not old, Scheffer's just been away from the rodeo arena for awhile.

When Scheffer last competed heavily in the Northern Rodeo Association, she had just finished second at the 1988 NRA Finals, which determined the 1987 champions.

Then she seemed to disappear.

Actually, she got married and started competing in the team penning with her then husband.

"I was just trying to be the good wife, wanting to be with my husband," said Scheffer, who lives in Hamilton. "Unfortunately, the marriage didn't work out."

Scheffer, with her maiden name back

and a new horse, Foxy, is competing in rodeo again.

"Boy, I tell you, I'm glad to be back. My friends were in rodeo," said Scheffer, who is also the coach for the University of Montana women's rodeo team.

In the past three years, the UM rodeo team has become a national contender and finished fifth this past year. She herself won the national all-around title and barrel racing titles for UM in 1985.

"Rodeo is in my blood, more or less."

Scheffer actually began her comeback last year at the PRCA NILE Rodeo in October. This year, she beefed up her schedule and competes in both barrel racing and breakaway roping.

"Foxy is a seven-year-old horse I've been training," said Scheffer, who won five consecutive NRA all-around titles (1982-86) and three barrel racing titles ('82, '85, '86).

"She's just starting to come into her own and been doing real well. I don't want to overdo it this year, we'll just see how things go. We might go real strong next year."

Scheffer and Foxy had a time of 13.60 in barrel racing Saturday night to put themselves in the money. Scheffer, fourth in the barrel racing standings and fifth in the all-around standings, took a no time in breakaway roping.

But she's definitely enjoying this year.

"Rodeo is a sport, when you do well, you can hear people in the back say, 'Well done, good job,'" Scheffer said.

Marty's motivated

With four titles in five years, Marty Penrod was running out of motivational tools.

This year, he found two and he didn't have to look very far.

The Miles City bull rider sees them almost every weekend at a rodeo somewhere in the state.

Penrod, whose name has become synonymous with Northern Rodeo Association bull riding success the past five years, is in a heated battle with Justin Blankenship and Dan Wigert for the year-end title. Only \$900 separates the three as the NRA regular-season enters its final weeks of competition.

And Penrod loves every minute.

"You have to give all the credit to Dan and Justin this year to what I've accomplished," said Penrod, not only considered one of the best NRA bull riders, but also one of the nicest. "I was a guy who needed a push and they've provided it."

"During the last couple of years, I didn't have a challenge, something to motivate me. We've been neck-and-neck all year, kind of trading places at the rodeos. Those two have really pushed me. I have to give the credit to them."

Penrod who turns 36 next month, came to the MontanaFair at Metra in third place for the standings. He's earned \$5,318 this summer and is just \$230 behind Blankenship. Wigert leads the standings with \$6,248. Both Wigert and Blankenship ride Saturday night.

But three things have Penrod focused in on a fifth title: a healthy knee, past experiences and an ever increasing white-hot competitive desire.

Last year, he had major knee surgery after the regular season. Still hesitant, he covered all three bulls at the NRA Finals this January to win the championship. The doubt was finally erased with a strong run during the Fourth of July this year.

"There was a lot of apprehensive thought about it," admitted Penrod. "Not when you ride, but when you get off. You start thinking about landing wrong, 'Will it hold up again.'"

"Everything was great. Then I knew I had a couple of more years left in me."

Penrod added that he traditionally rides well in August.

And there is another reason he looks forward to the rest of the year and the NRA Finals.

"I've got awful competitive in the past few years," Penrod said with a chuckle. "More than I ever was. I still want to be the year-end champion."

"I need that competition and those guys are pushing me to the maximum of my potential."

Penrod, for the first time since 1993, got thrown from his bull at Metra. Penrod lost the battle with the bull Dice.

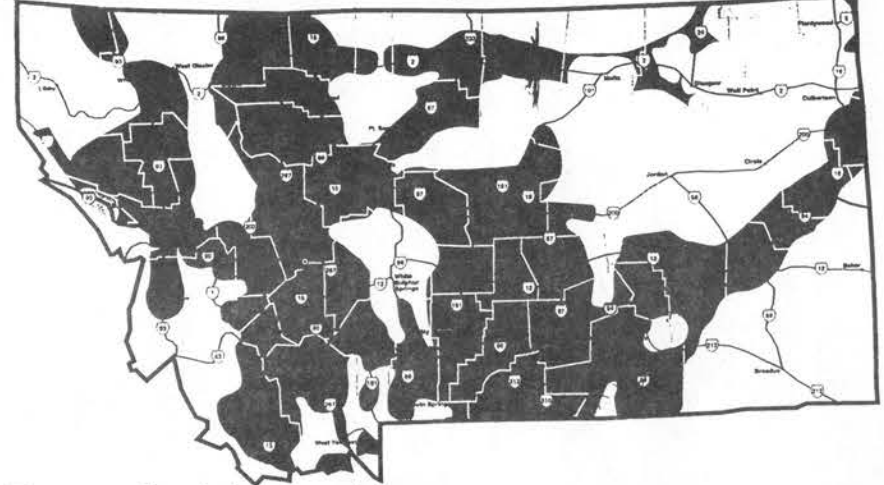
