BOARD MEETING MINUTES

In Memory of Bob Smith

One of our favorite sporting events is rodeo bull riding. Probably because it is one of the most dramatic, most exciting, most dangerous events there is. It is violent, and we love it. Just like we love bone-crunching football plays and good crashes on the race-car circuit. It is, unfortunately, what sports has become---video clip after video clip of death-defying action. But until the worst nightmare comes true, we don't appreciate what bull riders face. The fun of a country rodeo in a small Montana town was shattered on Labor Day when a bull rider was killed. Bob Smith, 36, of Boulder was thrown and stepped on by a bull at the Helmsville Rodeo. It is exactly how every bull ride could end and rodeo fans know it. But of course, nobody really wants it to end that way. But, we're not here to decry rodeo as just another violent sport. There is too much tradition - a working tradition, from the sometimes dangerous working environment of western ranches - that is behind the sport. Cowboys know what rodeoing is about, they make the choice to face the danger. We hope Bob Smith's death doesn't dampen our love of rodeo and bull riding, but gives us a deeper appreciation for it - a deeper appreciation for a cowboy's way of life.

Bobby's life ended doing what he loved "riding bulls". Bobby was born on Mach 25, 1958, to George Albert Smith and Katherine Eva Rowe Vitt. He enjoyed many childhood accomplishments that included membership in the Helena Boxing Club winning the coveted Golden Gloves Championship and competing and placing fifth at the World Steer Riding Finals in Fresno, California in 1972.

Bobby graduated from the Erv Malnich Outfitter and Guide School, attended the Lower River Columbia College and was an honor graduate from Nebraska Custom Diesel Truck Driving School in Omaha, Nebraska.

Bobby spent a good portion of his life in rodeo, competing in the bull riding event and qualifying for the Montana Rodeo Association Finals five separate years. While never attaining professional standing in his career choice, Bobby was pursuing this goal at the time of his death. His desire and ability to achieve world champion status was a major part of his life.

Bobby married Laura Novak Smith and they brought Angela Nicole Smith into the world in 1979.

Bobby married Marla Wolstein Wilson and Denny Calhous Smith was born to them in 1984.

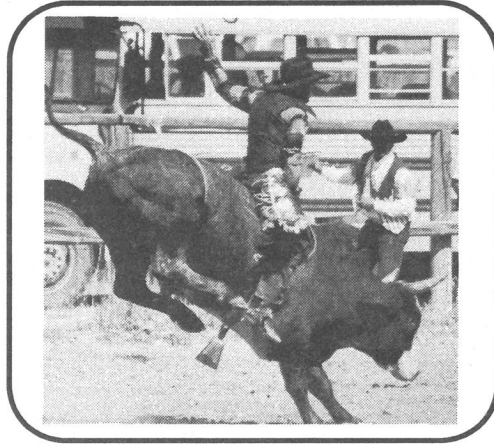
Bobby married for time and eternity to Samantha Lenzmeier Smith in 1988, to which Bailey Marykate and Cody George Smith were born in 1990 and 1994 respectively.

In addition to his love for bull riding, Bobby also broke and trained colts, was extremely active in his callings in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, was an accomplished big game hunter, loved to fish and ski. Bobby's love for his life and the many interests he had was surpassed only by his love for his children and his wife. Bobby's life was centered and anchored around his family. He spent every moment of his final years attending the children's activities and in family centered activities. he was the most doting and attentive and loving father imaginable. He was the best and most loving husband a wife could ask for.

Bobby is survived by his wife, Samantha and children, Bailey, Cody, Denny, and Angie; his mother and step-father, Katie and Robert Vitt of Helena; his brother and sister-in-law, Ed and Burt and their children, Carrie and Brian of Phoenix, AZ; his sister and brother-in-law, Connie and Charlie Mathews and their children, Misty, Holy, CB, Andra and Becky and their spouses of Sun River; his sister and brother-in-law, Cindy and Jerry Mielke and their son, Ryan of Spokane, Wa; his sister and brother-in-law Diane (DeDe) and Rick Morse and their daughters, Amber and Sonja of Anaconda. Bobby is also survived by step-brothers and step-sisters and their spouses and children, Marty and Bob Vitt, Jr. of Belgrade, Patty Mathes of Helena and Diane and Ted Schramm of San Diego, Calif; his in laws James and Veneta Lenzmeier and Jean and Michael Smith and their children, Emily and Andrew, all of Great Falls.

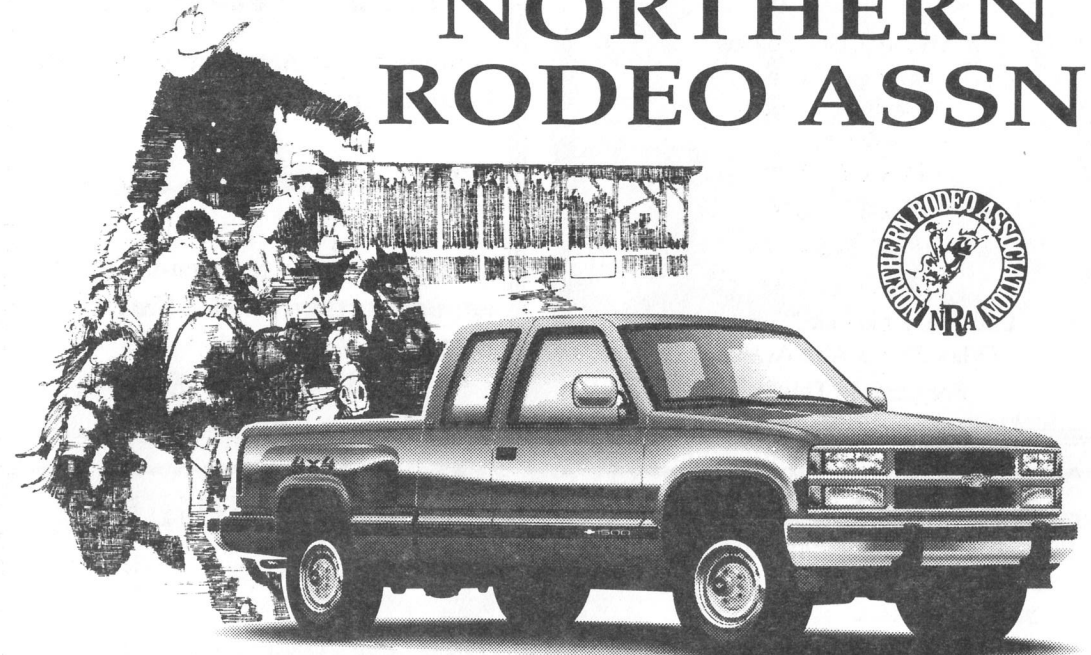

ANNUAL FAIR CONVENTION SCHEDULED FOR BILLINGS

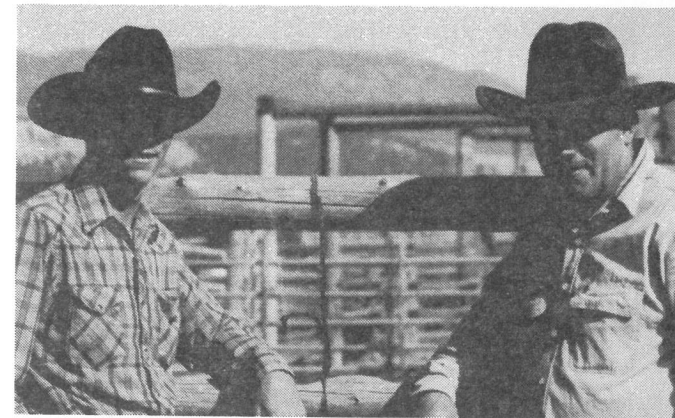

A variety of meetings and seminars are scheduled during the convention with show casing of talent during some meals and all afternoon on Thursday.

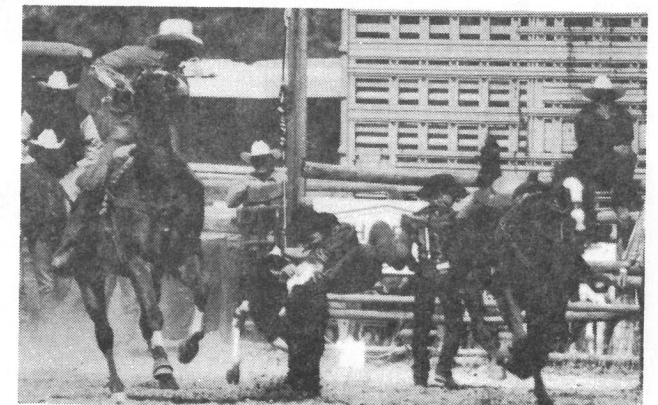

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Awards Program: All 1994 Championship event and all-around saddles have been ordered from individual Montana Saddlemakers.

North American Rodeo Commission: NRA has joined NARC for 1994. Dues are \$2,500. NRA will receive \$1675. in sponsorship dollars from Rocky Mountain Clothing as a result of NARC membership. World Finals Rodeo is scheduled for Nov. 1-5 in El Paso. NRA is eligible to send three per event.

Finals Committee: NRA Finals jackets were discussed. The company which makes the NFR jackets will be making this year's NRA Finals coats. Finals stock was discussed. Contract with Runquist has been extended through the 1996 Finals.

Rocky Mountain Association of Fairs: This year's convention will be held in Billings Nov. 9-12. All stock contractors and other interested members are encouraged to attend.

OLD BUSINESS:

Dues structure was addressed. It was moved and seconded: THE NRA OFFER A "ONE RODEO PERMIT" FOR \$25. THIS PERMIT WILL ALLOW A CONTESTANT TO COMPETE AT ONE NRA RODEO. CONTESTANT MUST PAY CASH, POINTS DO NOT COUNT, AND NEWSLETTER IS NOT INCLUDED. PASSED.

Clarification on dues increase from March meeting: It was moved and seconded: ANNUAL CONTESTING MEMBERSHIP DUES WILL BE \$80 THROUGH MAY 1, AND \$100 THEREAFTER. PASSED.

Lunch Break.

Tootie Rasmussen reviewed timers seminars conducted throughout the year. Seminars were held in Helena, Conrad, Malta, Absarokee, Culbertson, and Hamilton with 49 people attending and becoming certified. Seminars were successful and will continue with seminars held at the NRA Finals in February in addition to other locations. It was moved and seconded: TOOTIE RASMUSSEN'S SUBMITTED TIMERS SEMINAR EXPENSES BE REIMBURSED. Passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Rules of Competition proposed rule changes were brought before the Board at this time.

*When roping muley cattle, the legal catch in the Ladies Breakaway roping will be catch as catch can after the loop passes over the entire head of the animal. Discussion. DEFEATED******

The use of a spotter was recommended and will be further discussed at judging seminars.

*Committee or stock contractor has the option of using rubberbands or string to tie neck ropes. DEFEATED******

NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion concerning rulebook clarification on application of certain rules which have been trouble spots for judges and directors. A "Casebook" will be worked up and included in the next edition of the rulebook which will give

examples for judges to refer to. Judges Committee to put casebook together along with Tootie Rasmussen. Event directors are asked to send in most frequent problem scenarios to the NRA Office.

Doctor and vet releases were addressed. It was moved and seconded: THE NRA IMPOSE A \$10 PROCESSING FEE FOR EACH RODEO A DOCTOR OR VET RELEASE IS USED BY A CONTESTANT. Passed.

Rules of Competition proposed rule changes were brought before the Board. The following was passed for consideration and will be acted on at the February meeting:

*In the barrel racing event, if the rodeo is paid off in hand times, times used for payoff to be tenths. PASSED******

Added money difference between the rough stock and timed events was addressed in addition to even lower added money in the breakaway roping event. It was requested that the NRA office include a letter with the sanction packet to the committees asking them to consider equal added money for all events.

Discussion concerning current NRA buddy system for entries.

Allowing 12 contestants per event at the NRA Finals was addressed.

Vance Ruff's position in the NRA office was discussed.

Vacancies on the NRA Board of Directors for the 1995 year were addressed. Nominations were accepted for these open positions and nominations will remain open until December 1. Nominations as follows: President: Charlie Briggs, Nancy Petersen, Steve Cutler; Vice President: Rod Brosz, Dale McQueary; Team Roping: Mark Salmond, Bill Ayre; Steer Wrestling: Steve Blixt; Junior Events: Cinde Barthelmess, Dennis Tryan, Zana Lytle; Bull Riding: Marty Penrod.

Rodney Newman was appointed by the Board as Stock Contractor Director to fill the term left vacant by Dale Small.

Meeting adjourned.
