## Breakaway catch rule should be left as is

To: Breakaway Ropers

Subject: Proposed Catch-as-Catch-Can Rule change

Before you make up your mind on which way to vote on this rule change, be sure that you think about the total NRA image, not just the illegal catches that you had last year that cost you money.

REMEMBER: The present rule (neck-only catch) was made so that 1) we would bring a little something special to our region and 2) to improve the quality of breakaway roping. We accomplished both.

1) "NRA Rules" is what the rest of the world calls the neck-only catch. 2) In the past, a lot of money was won with the loop lying on the arena floor - - many people in the stands did not even see the catch. Most ropers don't like to get beat by someone who doesn't even leave the rope on the calf.

With our present rule, flagmen are making fewer errors now than ever before.

We should leave the rule as is.





He was also Wyoming's Rodeo Assocaition champ in 1983. Walker split the average at the finals after winning the second round and fourth in the final go. #### 2. Craig Miller, Miles City - \$ 4,363.02

#### 4. Phillip Whiteman, Jr., Lamedeer - \$ 2,438.60





This is her fourth year at the finals and her tenth year as an NRA member. The Glendive school teacher says her dad and mom, John and Kathy Chaffee most influenced her career. And she notes, when she remembers to enter, BillingsFair is her favorite rodeo. Not a wonder since she consistently ropes tough in the Metra. Her \$1,200 win over the finals weekend attest to that.

#### 2. Janie Carlson, Two Dot - \$3,784.32

The ranch woman from Two Dot is a past champion breakaway roper. She won the first round of the finals with a rapid 2.6 and won second in the average for the rodeo.

She owns and operates a tax preparation service in Hardin.

Twenty-two-year old Pete Petersen made his first trip to the finals this year. He won third in the average at this year's finals after winning a third and a fourth in the goes. He won a buckle for a first place in Polson this year and considers it his best rodeo win. When he's not rodeoing or hitting the books at WEstern Montana College, Petersen enjoys basketball, girls, football and skiing. We are not sure if the order of those events is correct.



#### North American Rodeo Commission

El Paso, Tx Feb. 15

NARC President Tom Harvey opened the meeting with a welcome to all associations and introduced his board of directors. All associations representatives introduced themselves. Seventeen associations were represented at the meeting.

Tom Harvey talked about his new slogan, "Team Work means Success." He feels the organization has been stagnate. He stated, it is time to move forward with teamwork. Tom also discussed with associations, complaints about the office in 1990. Tom assured everyone that things would be better in 1991. He assured association that someone would be at the NARC office from 9 - 5 everyday to take their calls.

Tom read the financial statement for 1990. Advising associations that an updated report would be sent from our accountant shortly. Tom stated NARC netted \$31,000 of the CWFR this year.

Tom stated that due to the war in the Middle East, the economy in El Paso was down making it hard to get local sponsorships. Tom asked if there were any questions and Bob Moore representing MSRA asked about relations with the Rotarians. Tom answered they need to do a better job for the rodeo. Rotarians committed for the 1991 success. Tom stated that if not, we will have to make a change.

Tom explained Coors Contract to the Associations. Stressing the point of getting association finals reports in on time. Tom also informed associations of Resistol adding \$5,000 more for sponsorships.

Tom introduced Don Sober of Coors. Don explained Coors involvement with CWFR and Associations. Don Stated that Coors had been involved for 13 years with NARC and is the exclusive beef for the NARC. And what this means is associations shouldn't go after Budweiser or Miller or Don will go after Tom and cuss him. Don says to call with problems at

any time.

Marv Pulman at this time discussed corporate sponsors. Marv stated that he had sent out 14 proposals this year thus far. He sent out proposals to motels, petroleum companys, Coca Cola, and many more. Also do what you promise in the proposal and send in a production report so the sponsor will know these promises have been fulfilled.

Tom Harvey presented Hawaii Rodeo Association to the members and the board for approval. Decision was to get more information from them before a decision could be made.

Northern Plains Rodeo Association was presented for membership by Jim Mosbrucker. After much discussion between members and board, they moved: to think about it and decide the next day. There was much questioning about whether or not each association should have a board of directors. David Loyd made a motion that each member association needs a board of directors. Bill Geipel from National Entry System made a presentation.

Tom addressed members on selling raffle tickets to pay their dues for 1991. Everyone agreed it was a good idea. Membership dues will be set up for first payment due March 1991 in the amount of \$1,000. The balance due in April and May.


Harvey requested a membership list from all associations. Also discussed needing new board members. He asked anyone interested to send in a resume to the NARC office before April 15.

DALE SMALL, SECONDED. PASSED. Discussion. SKEETER NORDAHL MOVED: EACH NRA COMMITTEE WILL HAVE AN ADDITIONAL 6TICKETS AVAIL-ABLE FOR PURCHASE AT 1/2 PRICE. JIM BUSHNELL, SECONDED. PASSED.

Renewal on George Runquist's contract was discussed. A committee was formed to work on (Continued on the next page) the details. Runquist contract committee members include: Lyle Baumann, Jim Bushnell, Charlie Briggs, Rodger Nordahl, Bill Parker, Tom Holland, Ed Waldhauser, Jann Parker.

A position for representation on the NRA Board of Directors for contract Personnel was discussed. SKEETER NORDAHL MOVED: THE NRA EXPAND THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO INCLUDE A REPRESENTATIVE FOR CONTRACT PERSONNEL, WITH A TWO YEAR TERM, TO BE VOTED ON AT THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR IN THE EVEN NUMBERED YEARS. (AMEND ARTICLE 2 PAGE 2 NRA RULEBOOK) LYLE BAU-MANN, SECONDED. PASSED.

Fining procedure for inhumane treatment of livestock by contestants or contractors was discussed. It was voted on and passed at the General Membership meeting that the Board approved the following fining procedure. Discussion.

JIM BUSHNELL MOVED: AN INCIDENCE OF ANIMAL ABUSE OR MISTREATMENT OF STOCK, IN OR OUT OF THE ARENA, WITNESSED BY TWO NRAMEMBERS AND REPORTED TO THE NRA OFFICE OR RODEO OFFICIAL, WILL RESULT IN \$50 FINE FOR FIRST OFFENSE; \$500 FINE, SECOND OFFENSE; DISQUALIFICATION FROM PARTICIPATION AT NRA RODEOS FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SEASON, THIRD OFFENSE; THIS ALSO APPLIES TO ANY CO-APPROVED RODEO WITH THE NRA. LEONARD WORTMAN, SECONDED. PASSED.

Length of scores was discussed. It was voted on and passed at the General Membership meeting that the Board consider the following changes in length of scores. Discussion. IT WAS MOVED AND SECONDED: SCORE LINE (NOT NECKROPE) WILL BE SET:

SW: (MINIMUM)LENGTH OF BOX MINUS 6 FEET; CR: (MINIMUM) LENGTH OF BOX MINUS 4 FEET; TR: (MINIMUM)LENGTH OFBOX MINUS 2 FEET; LBAR: GOVERNED BY TYPE OF CATTLE ROPED

SCORE LINE WILL BE SET ACCORDING TO ARENA AND BOX LENGTH AND CON-DITIONS, BUT WHEN CONDITIONS WAR-RANT. THE SCORE SHALL BE SET AS STATED ABOVE.

It was passed at the General Membership meeting that an additional dollar per contestant be added to the contestant's charges at each rodeo entered, to be earmarked for use as added money at the NRA Finals. Discussion. BILL PARKER MOVED; \$1 BE ADDED TO EACH CONTESTANT'S CHARGES FOR USE AS ADDED MONEY FOR NRA FINALS. ED MILLER SECONDED. Discussion. DE-FEATED\*\*\*\*\*

Numbers of timed event cattle were discussed. NRA Board urges each committee to keep in contact with contractor and central entry to see that correct numbers of timed event cattle will be used at their rodeo.

Discussion regarding change in legal loop for breakaway roping event.

Judges seminars: Board would like to have two seminars before June to encourage new judges. Committee Convention held Saturday morning was reviewed. Stan Steen and Stan Rasmussen were co-chairmen. Committees who attended were asked to rate the seminar on a 1-5 scale, 5 being the highest. Of 32 in attendance, 16 rated the seminar a 5, 8 a 4 rating, and 6 a 3 rating. LYLE BAUMANN MOVED: THE NRA GIVE GLEN HOUGH \$2,000 FOR HIS WORK IN HIS LAST TERM AS PRESIDENT, AND TOM HOLLAND \$2,000 FOR HIS WORK IN HIS TERM AS PRESIDENT. STACEY BAU-MANN, SECONDED. PASSED.

MEMBERSHIP: Entitles purchaser to work all sanctioned rodeos without restrictions, to share all advantages of a member in good standing including such items as a guarantee of your entry fee; check writing privileges after the first year initiation period; and a subscription to the newsletter.

**NEWSLETTER**: The official publication of the NRA featuring current data regarding the Association and NRA sanctioned rodeos, information of all association business, as well as interesting news articles and exciting photos.

PERMITS: Entities purchaser to work all sanctioned rodeos accepting permits as listed in the newsletter until \$500 is won. After \$500 money limit is won by permit holder, a card must be purchased. The price of card to be the dollar difference between the cost of a permit and the cost of the card. Permit holder's points will be credited to the yearend standings, however, the contestant must be a card holder to compete at the NRA Finals. The \$500 money limit will be accumulated from year to year, allowing the contestant to purchase a permit each year until the \$500 is won. A card holder the previous year cannot purchase a permit the following year. Back side of application must be completed to guarantee processing of membership application.

#### RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE

I make this choice even though I have observed or participated in events of this kind in the past and know conditions. facilities, rodeo animals, and other rodeo contestants and participants pose a danger to me. I recognize and expressly agree to assume the entire risk of any and all accidents or personal injury including serious paralysis or death which I might suffer during my participation in said events.

I further COVENANT AND AGREE NOT TO SUE THE NRA for any injury, damages or death which occur as a result of my participation in said events and any claim or damage therefore. I understand that this document maybe treated as a complete defense to any legal action I might bring against the NRA for any injuries or other damages I might suffer.

I understand and agree this RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE extends to any all claims I may have, specially including but not limited to, claims arising out of participation in said events, claims with respect to the design, manufacture, repair, or maintenance of the facilities or equipment which I will be using, or with respect to the conditions, qualification, instructions, rules or procedures under which my use of said facilities or equipment are conducted or from any other cause.
