## Office Updates

### Contestants:

*Don't miss this one! Important new change for the 1998 season affects you!*

**Rule M.1.10.1.** All individuals must purchase their card through the NRA office before they can enter a rodeo. The application must be signed, witnessed or notarized and have correct amount of money submitted or it will be refused. *The application must reach the NRA office 5 (five) days before entries are taken.*

And, if you or someone you know was placed on the NRA's ineligible list for a turn-out prior to 1992, you have now been granted amnesty! The Board voted at their fall meeting to clear all fines (except NSF checks) prior to 1992.

The NRA Office accepts VISA and Mastercards, too.



During the February board meeting, the Board voted that:

Slack may be used as a first preference when entering an NRA rodeo, however, **performances must be filled before any slack preference is recognized.** All slacks are if necessary.

Be sure and read the section in this newsletter titled "How to Enter" ...these tips will make entering and achieving your entry goal much easier.

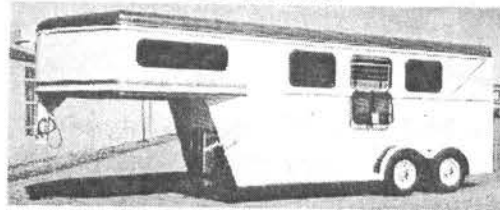

## Where are they Now?

This is the first in a series of what our past champions are doing. Rodeo people are a family in the greatest sense: Grandparents of the 1990's cheer on their own grandchildren as well as grandchildren of their peers. Once you have been active in rodeo life, it seems there is no way to "let go". Let us reminisce about the "greats" of the past.

Seven Championships. Bob Schall won 13 Bareback titles, Glen Hough was 13 Team Roping titles.

Arlene Haugland of Belgrade and her bay mare Cindy won 7 Montana Rodeo Association Barrel Racing titles. Not much publicity about this tough competitor and her good horse because the championships were in 1955 through 1965.

The amount of year-end money Arlene won is impressive because entry fees were only \$10 and some were \$5 (with no extra charges!) and a high purse was \$100. Consistency was important because almost every rodeo was a two-header.

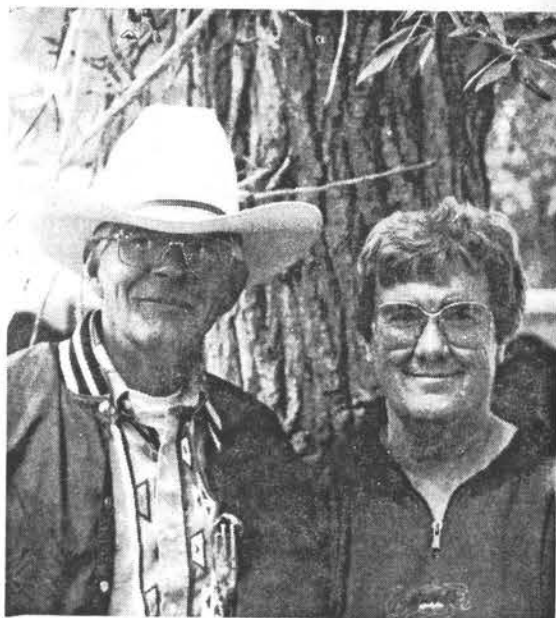
Bob bought Cindy for \$35 from a neighbor, she was part thoroughbred.

Besides being a natural and a self-trained barrel racer, Arlene is a walking miracle. She is coping with a blood disorder called Aplastic Anemia. Thirteen years ago she was diagnosed with this disease and continues to take medication to keep it in remission. This has not prevented her from an active rodeo life.

She has been chosen to be a timer at the NRA Finals for 3 years. Her daughter, Deb Lloyd, competes in the breakaway roping and barrel race; her

granddaughter, Kylee Haugland, competes in all the junior events. At every jackpot and/or rodeo the Arlene attends, she keeps a record of EVERYONE'S name and time in EVERY event. In fact, if you want to know who placed in the barrel race (for instance) at Townsend in 1975, Arlene has it on file!

She and her husband Bob have raised and trained many horses in the past, have both been active as directors at all levels of rodeo and continue to be supportive of rodeo.

## A History Lesson

The NRA was not always the NRA.

There was the Montana Amateur Rodeo Association (MARA) and there was the North Central Montana Rodeo Association (NCMRA). The MARA changed their name to MRA in 1964, the NCMRA changed their name to NRA in 1966. Then in 1984 the two associations merged and today's Northern Rodeo Association was formed.

The merger between the Montana Rodeo Association and the Northern Rodeo Association was not popular with

everyone: some people's identity and/or their sense of belonging was lost.

Today, some young contestants might not appreciate the historical development and struggles that took place.

Regional rodeo has grown in many ways and has stayed the same in many ways.

Summarized quite well in a Billings Gazette article that appeared prior to the NRA Finals, it states:

"The Northern Rodeo Association is a lot of different things for the competing cowboys and cowgirls.

For some, it is the starting point for a rodeo career that unfolds before them.

For others, it's a place where friends

and family will always be. A place where no one is ever far away and always welcomed back.

They might have different goals and be on different paths, but the top 10 cowboys and cowgirls will be in the same place at the NRA Finals.

The NRA is the starting point for competitors like Josh

Reynolds, trying to win his second consecutive saddle bronc title. It's home for Bob Schall of Arlee, the winningest cowboy in NRA history..."

Through change and growing pains your Association has evolved into what it is today.

For others, it's a place where friends and family will always be. A place where no one is ever far away and always welcomed back."

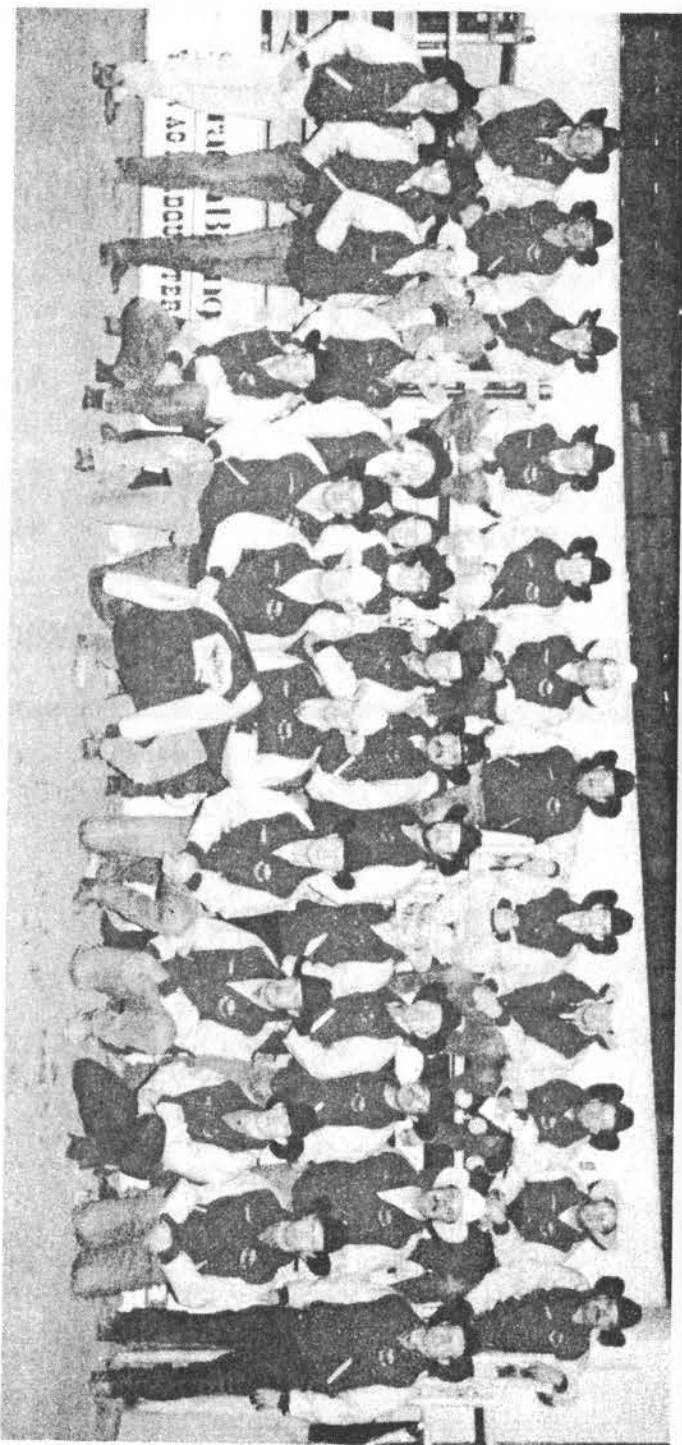

**MEMBERSHIP:** Entitles purchaser to work all sanctioned rodeos without restrictions, to share all advantages of a member in good standing including such items as a guarantee to your entry fee; check writing privileges after the first year initiation period; and a subscription to the newsletter.

**PERMITS:** Entitles purchaser to work all sanctioned rodeos accepting permits as listed in newsletter until \$500 is won. After \$500 money limit is won by permit holder, a card must be purchased, the price of card to be the dollar difference between the cost of a permit and the cost of the card. Permit holder's points will be credited to the year-end standing, however, the contestant must be a card holder to compete at the NRA Finals. The \$500 money limit will be accumulated from year to year, allowing the contestant to purchase a permit each year until the \$500 is won. A card holder the previous year cannot purchase a permit the following year.

# RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE

In consideration of being allowed to participate in Northern Rodeo Association sanctioned events and membership in the Association, I and my heirs, successors, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE and agree to HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the Northern Rodeo Association, the rodeo committees, stock contractors, sponsors, arena operations or owners, their agents, representatives (collectively referred to as the NRA) from all liability me and my personal representatives, heirs, successors, and next of kin from any and all claims and liability for all loss of damage, and any claim of damages therefore on account of any injury to my person including death or damage to my property while I am utilizing NRA facilities or participating in NRA events.

I, hereby represent to the NRA that I understand that THERE ARE CERTAIN RISKS OF SERIOUS INJURY AND DEATH inherent in participating in rodeo events and any related activities. I realize conditions of the rodeo arena change from time to time and may become more hazardous, that rodeo animals are dangerous and unpredictable and there is INHERENT DANGER in rodeo which I appreciate and voluntarily assume because I choose to participate in such events. I make this choice even though I have observed or participated in events of this kind in the past and know conditions, facilities, rodeo animals, and other rodeo contestants and participants pose a danger to me. I recognize and expressly agree to assume the entire risk of any and all accidents or personal injury including serious paralysis or death which I might suffer during my participation in said events.

I further COVENANT AND AGREE NOT TO SUE THE NRA for any injury, damages or death which occur as a result of my participation in said events and any claim or damage therefore. I understand that this document may be treated as a complete defense to any legal action I might bring against the NRA for any injuries or other damages I might suffer.

I understand and agree this RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE extends to any and all claims I may have, specially including, but not limited to, claims arising out of participation in said events, claims with respect to the design, manufacture, repair, or maintenance of facilities or equipment which I will be using, or with respect to the conditions, qualification, instructions, rules or procedures under which my use of said facilities or equipment are conducted or from any other cause.

I UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THIS RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE extends to ACCIDENT, INJURY, OR DEATH OCCURRING DURING THE TERM OF MY MEMBERSHIP IN THE NRA. Any subsequent Releases and agreement I might sign in the future shall amplify, but shall in no way limit, the provisions of this document.

I further state and certify that I have carefully read the foregoing Release, know the contents thereof and sign this Release and Agreement Not to Sue as a free and voluntary act. I am not relying on any statements of representations of any party released hereby. I UNDERSTAND THIS IS A RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS and that my facsimile signature on this application and release constitutes an original signature.

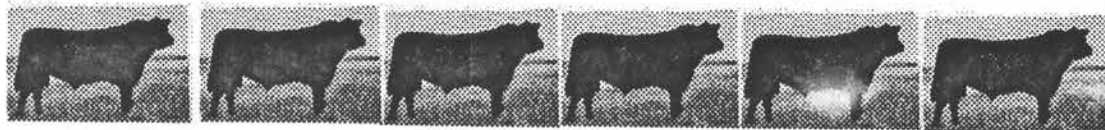

## 1997 Northern Rodeo Association RULECHANGES Supplement to current rulebook:

LBR contestant order at the NRA Finals was addressed. It was moved and seconded: For the NRA Finals rodeo, the ladies barrel racers will run in the 1st through 10th position for the first go; For the second and third go-arounds, the order of the event will be the contestant's finish in prior go-arounds. There will be no trading of positions at the NRA Finals. PASSED.

It was moved and seconded: adjustment to rule (pg 31, A.6.4) ...eight places, \$3,000 up to \$7,500, ten places \$7,500 and up. 12 place payoff is eliminated. PASSED.

It was moved and seconded: amend pg 30, A.5.23: A contestant's entry fees must be paid or arrangements made for payment prior to the payoff for that event or contestant is subject to a \$100 fine plus his fees. PASSED.

It was moved and seconded: amend page 37 D.5.1: Fine for NSF check will \$100. If rodeo secretary is assessed a service charge, secretary will be reimbursed for charge when submitted to NRA Office along with NSF check. PASSED.

Discussion concerning Finals stock. It was moved and seconded: amend page 79 F.5.2: Any NRA stock contractor who meets the criteria to bring stock to the NRA Finals rodeo will choose ONE feature animal in the bareback, saddle bronc and bull riding events that will automatically come to the finals...PASSED.

Amendments/changes to existing program were addressed. It was moved and seconded: J.1.2 Level I: Is your seasoned rodeo judge and has several years of experience. Has a precise knowledge of the rules. Can enforce rules and is not intimidated by others. Judges without bias or inconsistency. Works well with committees, contractors, contestants, and fellow judges (not domineering or dictatorial).

Level II: Between a level I and III

Level III: Must have several years judging experience and has attended a judging seminar or conference within the past two years. Has a good knowledge of the rules and is an average judge.

Level IV: Between a III and V judge.

Level V: Has a minimal amount of judging experience. Has a fair knowledge of the rules.

## 1998 NORTHERN RODEO ASSOCIATION RULECHANGES: Supplement to current rulebook:

Add rule A.2.21. If stock contractor declines existing rodeo or cannot come to terms with existing rodeo committee this will open bidding to all NRA approved stock contractors. Unreasonable terms to be determined by advisory board. PASSED.

Amend rule D.10.0.: Turnouts: Turnout fine will match the entry fee and all additional charges (stock charge, central entry charge, judges charge, etc.) Ineligibility: violators will be ineligible to enter in NRA rodeos effective five (5) business days from the date of the last performance which turn-out occurred and will not regain eligibility until such time as fees and fine are paid in full. PASSED.

Add a rule M.2.1.6. Members are allowed to use Visa and/or MasterCard for purchasing memberships. A \$5.00 processing fee will be charged for each Visa and/or MasterCard use. PASSED.

Amend rule A.4.3. Slack may be used as a first preference when entering an NRA rodeo, however, performances must be filled before any slack preference is recognized. All slacks are as necessary. PASSED.

Amend rule R.11.13. Cattle used for steer wrestling shall not be used for team roping unless approved by stock contractor and steer wrestling and/or team roping director. PASSED.

Amend rule F.5.6. NRA stock contractors will be given the first opportunity to bring timed-event livestock to the NRA Finals. Director has final right of refusal 45 days prior to the first performance of the NRA Finals. PASSED.

Add a rule F.5.7. If animal does not perform in rough stock events during the NRA Finals to judges discretion there will be no payment made on that animal. PASSED.

Amend rule F.2.1. The rough stock judges (4) for the Finals rodeo, are selected by the year-end judges evaluation. The top four (4) rated judges will be eligible to judge the Finals rodeo. However, judges can only judge the NRA Finals two (2) years consecutively. PASSED UNANIMOUS.

Amend rule F.2.2. The timed event judge (1) for the Finals rodeo is selected by the year-end judges evaluation. The top rated judge will be eligible to judge the Finals rodeo. However, judges can only judge the NRA Finals two (2) years consecutively. PASSED UNANIMOUS.

Amend rule R.14.11.17. "In slack, ground throughout the barrel pattern must be worked (not raked) conditions permitting, immediately before and after the barrel race and after the equivalent number of contestants drawn for the largest performance minus notified turn-outs." PASSED UNANIMOUS.

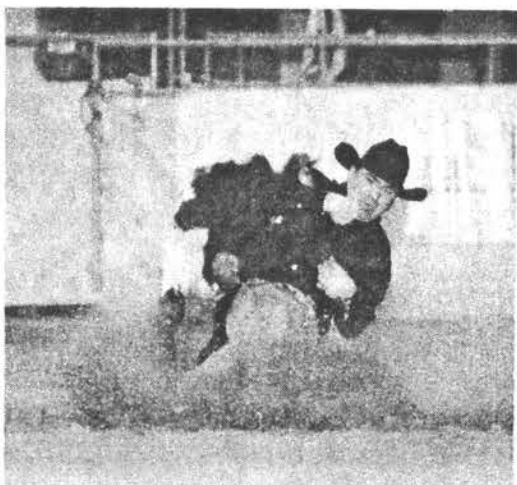

# Board of Directors Meeting

Saturday, April 4, 1998

Helena Fairgrounds

Helena, Montana

President Charlie Briggs called the meeting to order.

Roll was taken and a quorum verified. Those members present included: President, Charlie Briggs; Ray Brekke, Bareback Riding; Travis Caldwell, Calf Roping; Kent Robbins, Saddle Bronc Riding; Rodney Newman, Stock Contractor; Dick Lyman, Contract Personnel; Paula Harris, Barrel Racing; Dan Wigert, Bull Riding; Karen Miller, Advisory Board; Ed Waldhauser, Advisory Board; Committee Directors East: Mark Pinkerton; Committee Directors West: Leonard Wortman, Bob Graveley, Rodger Nordahl.

Financial Report was read and approved subject to audit. Association finances were discussed.

## COMMITTEEREPORTS:

**North American Rodeo Commission:** Ed Waldhauser updated board on NARC status. Location of World Finals Rodeo to be decided in the next month.

**Friends of Rodeo:** Karen Miller updated board. The NRA Office will be sending information supplied by Karen out to all NRA committees. Goal for the state of Montana is to increase memberships.

**NRA Finals:** Discussion on NRA Finals settlement.

**Judges Program:** Dick Lyman updated board on judging seminars, judges rating. Discussion on selection of NRA Finals judges.

**Logan Coach:** Theresa Caldwell updated board on Logan Coach finances. It was decided to embroider NRA judge's names on Logan Coach vests.

## OLD BUSINESS:

Max Hansen updated board on changes made in the contract to be entered into with Big Sky Rodeo Central Entry.

As per request from February Board of Directors meeting; discussion concerning revised rule section for stock contractors. After discussion and careful review, the Board of Directors voted to unanimously accept the following rule changes and amendments to the stock contractor rules:

*amend rule M.2.5. Stock Contractor Membership and Application Requirements. Applicants for Stock Contractor status who meet all requirements set forth herein shall purchase a stock contractor card for \$80.00 before May 1st, and \$100.00 thereafter. New Applicants will become Full Stock Contractor members after two dues-paying years. Applicants may obtain Probationary Stock Contractor status after one year if they have satisfied the requirements for applicants in the first dues-paying year after submitting their application. Applicants will have First-Year Stock Contractor status (First-Year Stock Contractor") during the dues-paying year in which they file their application.*

*amend rule M.2.5.1 Other Requirements.*

A) All Stock Contractors must own a minimum of 30 bareback and saddle bronc horses and 30 bulls, a record of which must be submitted annually to the N.R.A. two weeks prior to the Stock Contractor's first rodeo of the rodeo year, the Stock Contractor's first sub-contract for a rodeo, or June 1st, whichever event occurs first.

B) A N.R.A. stock contractor shall submit to the N.R.A. proof of ownership of any or all stock. (Proof of ownership may require submission of a notarized bill of sale, brand inspector's certificates or proof of payment.) Failure to provide this record or submit proof of

ownership, if requested, shall result in a \$100.00 fine.

C) Should the number of livestock owned by a N.R.A. stock contractor at any time be less than the minimum number required, that stock contractor shall no longer be considered eligible to act as a stock contractor at a N.R.A. sanctioned rodeo.

D) The N.R.A. shall have the authority to inspect a N.R.A. Member's stock at any time. Riding event livestock on record at the N.R.A. Office must be available for inspection at the home base or some other designated location within 14 days after notice is delivered to the stock contractor's home base. If the N.R.A., during the course of an inspection, discovers that a N.R.A. stock contractor is not in compliance with the requirements for N.R.A. stock contractors (including requirements for First-Year and Probationary Stock Contractors, if applicable) as set forth in these Bylaws or the Rules, that stock contractor will be assessed a \$50.00 inspection fee.

E) All Stock Contractors must be able to supply adequate numbers of acceptable timed event livestock in accordance with timed-event livestock rules outlined in these Rules. Copies of signed contracts for such timed event livestock shall be provided annually to the N.R.A. at the beginning of the rodeo season and thereafter during the season as the stock contractor changes his contractual arrangements.

F) All stock contractors must obtain a \$10,000.00 fidelity bond with the N.R.A. office which bond shall be forfeit in the event the stock contractor fails to timely pay any obligations owed to the N.R.A. A copy of said bond shall be filed with the N.R.A. office annually, and the stock contractor shall insure that the bonding agent notifies the N.R.A. of any change or lapse in coverage.

*amend rule M.2.5.2 Stock Contractor Review.* The Board of Directors may place an existing Stock Contractor on First-Year Stock Contractor status if the Board determines that the Stock Contractor has 1) supplied stock of inferior quality to N.R.A. sanctioned events, 2) violated the stock contractor requirements set forth in these Bylaws or the Rules, 3) staged substandard, lengthy or unprofessional productions, or 4) caused safety concerns either for the contestants, the

animals, other N.R.A. members, or other attendees of rodeos in a manner which substantially and adversely affects the well-being or the reputation of the sport of rodeo.

*add a rule M.2.5.3 First-Year Stock Contractors*

*M.2.5.3.1 First-Year Stock Contractors Requirements. First-Year Stock Contractors must comply with the following requirements in order to maintain First-Year Stock Contractor status:*

A) *Inspection. Prospective new stock contractors must be inspected and approved by the N.R.A. before applicant will be considered for First-Year Stock Contractor status. A \$50.00 inspection fee must be paid to the N.R.A. prior to inspection.*

B) *List of Existing Stock. An applicant for First-Year Stock Contractor status must submit a list of all existing stock owned by applicant which must have the applicant's brand, and must include a minimum of 30 bareback and saddle bronc horses and 30 bulls, and provide evidence of the availability of adequate timed event cattle. In the case of a firm, names of all persons claiming ownership must be listed indicating the owner of each animal.*

C) *New Rodeos. First-Year Stock Contractors must be the Primary Stock Contractor for at least three (3) new N.R.A. approved rodeos. A First Year Stock Contractor must serve as the Primary Stock Contractor at the three new rodeos for at least two years. Each of the new rodeos will be subject to periodic inspection. (See Bylaw M.2.5.4 for the production of an existing rodeo by a First-Year Stock Contractor.)*

D) *Supply of Equipment. In order to maintain First-Year Stock Contractor status, a First-Year Stock Contractor must supply equipment necessary to conduct each rodeo at which the First-Year Stock Contractor is stock contractor of record.*

E) *Compliance With Other Bylaws and Rules. First-Year Stock Contractors must comply with those bylaws and rules which apply to all N.R.A. stock contractors including, but not limited to, Bylaw M.2.5.1.*

*M.2.5.3.2 Temporary Membership Card. First-Year Stock Contractors will receive a*

temporary membership card until such First-Year Stock Contractor advances to Probationary Stock Contractor status, or until such First-Year Stock Contractor no longer qualifies as a First-Year Stock Contractor, whichever event occurs first. If the applicant's three new rodeos are not approved during his term as a First-Year Stock Contractor, his membership card will be rescinded. For First-Year Stock Contractors there will be a \$150.00 initiation fee in addition to the dues for the dues-paying year in which the initiation occurs. In addition, a fidelity bond of not less than \$10,000.00 must be posted, to be held in the N.R.A. Office as provided in M.2.5.1. Said bond, or any portion thereof, may be forfeited if a First-Year Stock Contractor owes the N.R.A. any financial obligation.

M.2.5.3.3 Voting Rights. First-Year Stock Contractors shall not have voting rights on matters pertaining to stock contractors and shall not be eligible for N.R.A. special events including the N.R.A. Finals Rodeo.

M.2.5.3.4 Production of Existing Rodeos. In order for First-Year Stock Contractors to produce an established N.R.A. approved rodeo (a rodeo that has been sanctioned by the N.R.A. for at least two years), such First-Year Stock Contractor must obtain approval from the Board of Directors.

add a rule M.2.5.4 Probationary Stock Contractors,

M.2.5.4.1 Requirements. If a First-Year Stock Contractor has met all requirements pertaining to a First-Year Stock Contractor at the end of the first dues-paying year after an application was made, said First-Year Stock Contractor will become a Probationary Stock Contractor provided that he continues to meet the following requirements:

A) New Rodeos. He must maintain the three (3) rodeos described in M.2.5.3(C). Failure to maintain these new rodeos will result in an automatic rescission of stock contractor membership status;

B) Inspection. The three (3) rodeos must pass a N.R.A. inspection during the probationary year;

C) Supply of Equipment. He must supply equipment necessary to conduct each rodeo at which he is the stock contractor of record; and

D) Compliance with Other Bylaws and Rules. Probationary Stock Contractors must comply with those bylaws and rules which apply to all N.R.A. stock contractor including, but not limited to, Bylaw M.2.5.1.

M.2.5.4.2 Voting Rights. Each Probationary Stock Contractor shall be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote of stock contractors but shall not be eligible for N.R.A. special events including the N.R.A. Finals Rodeo.

add a rule M.2.5.5 Full Stock Contractors  
M.2.5.5.1 Eligibility. Probationary Stock Contractors which have maintained at least three (3) new N.R.A. approved rodeos for two years, as described in M.2.5.4.1 and which have satisfied all other requirements for First-Year Stock Contractors and Probationary Stock Contractors shall be eligible to become Full Stock Contractors.

M.2.5.5.2 Requirements for Maintaining Full Stock Contractor Status. A Full Stock Contractor must comply with the following requirements in order to maintain Full Stock Contractor status:

A) Primary Stock contractor at No Less Than Three (3) Rodeos. A Full Stock Contractor must be the Primary Stock Contractor at a minimum of three (3) N.R.A. approved rodeos in a rodeo year.

B) Supply of Equipment. A Full Stock Contractor must supply equipment and stock necessary to conduct each rodeo at which the Full Stock Contractor is the stock contractor of record.

C) Compliance with Other Bylaws and Rules. Full Stock Contractors must comply with those bylaws and rules which apply to all N.R.A. stock contractors including, but not limited to, Bylaw M.2.5.1.

M.2.5.5.3 Failure to Comply with Requirements of Full Stock Contractors. Any Full Stock Contractor who fails to satisfy the requirement of serving as the Primary Stock Contractor at a minimum of five (5) N.R.A. rodeos in any two consecutive rodeo years or who fails to satisfy the other requirements set forth in these Bylaws shall forfeit Full Stock Contractor Status. In such an instance, the individual or firm which has forfeited Full Stock Contractor status will no longer be considered a N.R.A. stock contractor and must satisfy the requirements of First-Year Stock Contractors and Probationary Stock Contractors listed above in order to

regain Full Stock Contractor status. Such contractor shall not be eligible for any N.R.A. special events.

M.2.5.5.4 Voting Rights. Each Full Stock Contractor shall be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote of stock contractors.

M.2.5.5.5 Special Events Eligibility. Full Stock Contractors who meet the qualifications for a special event shall be eligible for a special event, such as the N.R.A. Finals Rodeo.

add a rule M.2.5.6 Transfer/Sale of Contracting Firm

M.2.5.6.1 Transfer of Stock Contracting Firm. Only a Full Stock Contractor's or Probationary Stock Contractor's N.R.A. membership card may be transferred to a new firm (individual, partnership, corporation or other legal entity) only in connection with the sale of all or substantially all of the transferring firm's livestock, equipment, rodeo contracts and other business assets to the transferee firm, with the transferee firm continuing the stock contracting business as a going concern. Such sale must include a minimum of 30 bareback and saddle bronc horses and 30 bulls. In the case of a qualifying sale transaction, the transferee stock contractor will not be required to satisfy the requirements of First-Year Stock Contractors or in the case where the transferor is a Full Stock Contractor, the requirements of Probationary Stock Contractors, in order to have the transferred card re-issued to the transferee's designated operating officer. Provided, however, as a condition to the transfer and re-issue of the stock contractor card in question, the N.R.A. shall require a copy of a signed bill of sale for all riding event livestock involved in the sale transaction and may require review of all terms and provisions of the contract documents concerning the transferor's sale of all or substantially all of its business assets as a going concern to the transferee as well as all other contractual relationships created or affected in connection with the transfer of the subject stock contractor card. Provided further that the N.R.A. Executive Committee may recommend for review and inspection any questionable new stock contractor to whom an existing N.R.A. Stock Contractor card is transferred and re-issued where the transferee has not itself satisfied the requirements of Stock Con-

tractors applicable to prospective new stock contractors.

M.2.5.6.2 Transferred Memberships. Any Full Stock Contractor whose N.R.A. membership is transferred and re-issued to a new firm in connection with the sale of the Full Stock Contractor's business shall have no further membership interests or rights in the N.R.A. as a stock contractor. In the event such former Full Stock Contractor desires to reinstate his N.R.A. stock contractor membership, he shall be required to satisfy all terms and conditions applicable to prospective new stock contractors.

## NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion concerning selection of judges for NRA Finals. It was moved and seconded: to amend rule F.2.1. The rough stock judges (4) for the Finals rodeo, are selected by the year-end judges evaluation. The top four (4) rated judges will be eligible to judge the Finals rodeo. However, judges can only judge the NRA Finals two (2) years consecutively. PASSED UNANIMOUS.

It was moved and seconded: to amend rule F.2.2. The timed event judge (1) for the Finals rodeo is selected by the year-end judges evaluation. The top rated judge will be eligible to judge the Finals rodeo. However, judges can only judge the NRA Finals two (2) years consecutively. PASSED UNANIMOUS.

Discussion concerning clarification of rule R.14.11.17. It was moved and seconded: to amend rule R.14.11.17. "In slack, ground throughout the barrel pattern must be worked (not raked) conditions permitting, immediately before and after the barrel race and after the equivalent number of contestants drawn for the largest performance minus notified turn-outs." PASSED UNANIMOUS.

## How to enter NRA Rodeos

**W**elcome to the Northern Rodeo Association. NRA rodeos have utilized Big Sky Rodeo Central Entry since 1984 and offer the following guidelines to assist you. Take a moment to familiarize yourself with the NRA's rules on Central Entry. They can be found in section A.4.0 in the rulebook. A thorough knowledge of the NRA rules which apply to entering will help you better achieve your entry objective.

UNLESS OTHERWISE ADVERTISED, rodeo entries will open at 10 a.m. and remain open through 6:30 p.m. every Monday preceding a rodeo weekend. Call backs open at 12 Noon and remain open through 6:30 p.m. every Tuesday. Per rodeo charge of \$3.50 per contestant. Please read your rodeo listings carefully as the entry dates that fall on days other than the Monday before the rodeo will be in bold lettering.

When entering, be prepared with the following information for the central entry operator:

1. Name of rodeo(s) you wish to enter
2. Your NRA card number
3. Your name
4. The event (s) you wish to enter
5. Preferences you have on which performances you wish to work.
6. Name of buddy or buddies - NRA rules allow for two per event, six total.  
(To buddy together you must enter together.)
7. If a multi-rodeo weekend, give information for each rodeo you wish to enter.
8. Call back Tuesday between 12 Noon and 6:30 p.m. (unless otherwise advertised)

to find out when you are up.

9. Keep a record of the confirmation number the central entry operator gives you, both upon entering the rodeo, and when you call back. Every conversation, both entry and call back, is recorded on tape, and each person calling is given a verification number for that conversation.

In the event of a discrepancy, you **MUST** have your confirmation number available. No complaints against Central Entry will be considered valid unless a confirmation number is given.

If you do not call back during the specified call back times, late call backs will be accepted at the late call back number 406-428-2398. There is an additional charge of \$2.50 per rodeo for this service.

## Drawouts, Tradeouts and Turnouts

The NRA Guidelines: for complete information, please refer to the NRA rulebook section A.8.0. The following is provided for your convenience.

**Drawouts:** At the time of call back, a contestant may draw out of a rodeo(s). There is not a charge IF you did not receive your preference of performances. However, rule A.4.1.4 states: "Any contestant who draws out of a rodeo after receiving their first preference of performance at a given rodeo or rodeos will be fined \$20 per infraction."

**Tradeouts:** All NRA rodeos are trade-out rodeos unless advertised in the rodeo listing as "No Tradeouts".

A contestants may trade positions/performances of competition with another contestant at anytime after entries close, provided it is before the stock draw for that event.

If a trade is completed before callbacks close, trades are handled through centray entry and may continue to be handled up until 10 a.m. the day following callbacks.

After 10 a.m. the day after callbacks, all trades are handled through the NRA Office 406-252-1122. Both parties involved in a trade must call the NRA office and confirm the trade.

Trades can be made at the rodeo upon consent of both parties involved before the draw in that event. Both judges and rodeo secretary must be notified of trade by both parties. NOTE: The timed-event draw must be made in the presence of the rodeo secretary and can be made a minimum of two hours before the performance. We bring this to your attention so contestants plan to make trades earlier.

**Turnouts:** As stated in the rulebook, if a contestant turns out at a rodeo, the fine will be equal to the entry fees. The NRA has rules which can soften the blow of an expensive turnout:

1. Notified turnout: If you know before 3 p.m. the last working day before the first performance of a ro-

deo that you will not be competing at this rodeo, call the NRA Office. You will be responsible for your entry fees plus a \$20 fine. The fine is \$20 (plus all entry fees) no matter how many events you are entered in.

2. If it is too late to notify the NRA Office, you can find someone who will pay your fees at the rodeo for you and notify the secretary, judges, and contractor that you will not be there, your fine is half your entry fee (plus the payment of your fees at the rodeo).

Courtesy, please. Contractors, judges, secretaries, spectators, announcers, and fellow contestants appreciate knowing if you will not be there, thus an animal will not be drawn and this eliminate unnecessary turnouts.

**Medical and Vet Releases:** As soon as you are aware that you will be unable to compete at an NRA rodeo you have entered due to a medical or vet release, contact the NRA office. With a medical or vet release you are not responsible for your fees but releases must be sent into the NRA office within five days after the rodeo along with a \$10 processing charge per rodeo.

Vet releases are accepted in the barrel racing event only. Keep in mind, when you medical or vet release, there is a five day waiting period before you can participate in another NRA rodeo.

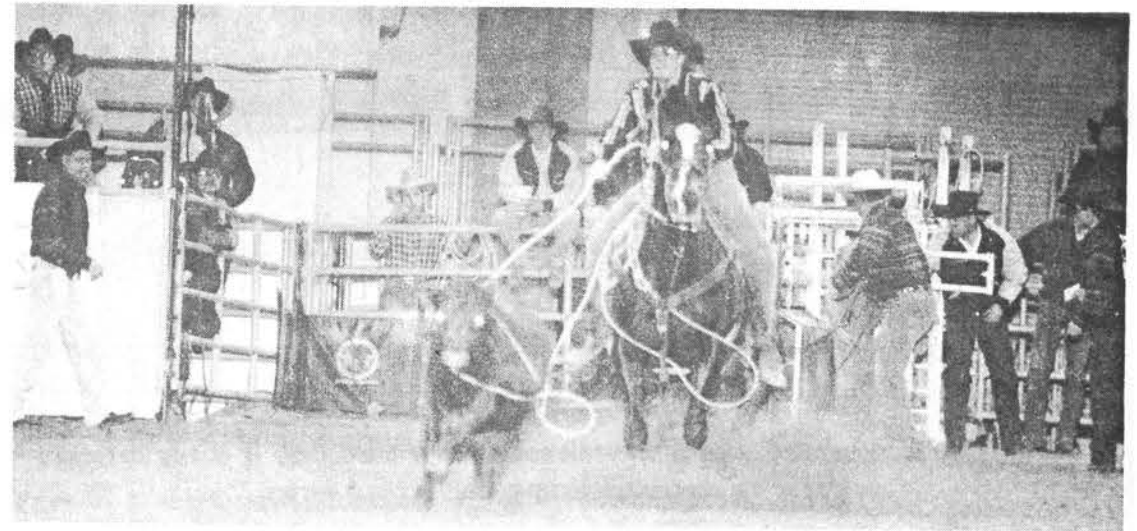
