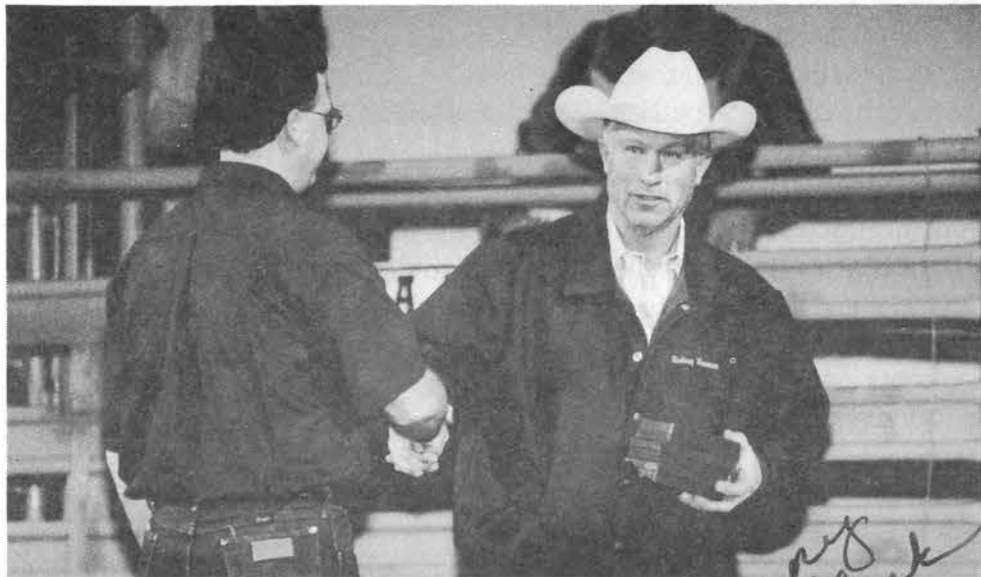

The Blazing Saddle hosted the 1997 Stock Contractors dinner held annually on the Wednesday preceding the NRA Finals weekend.

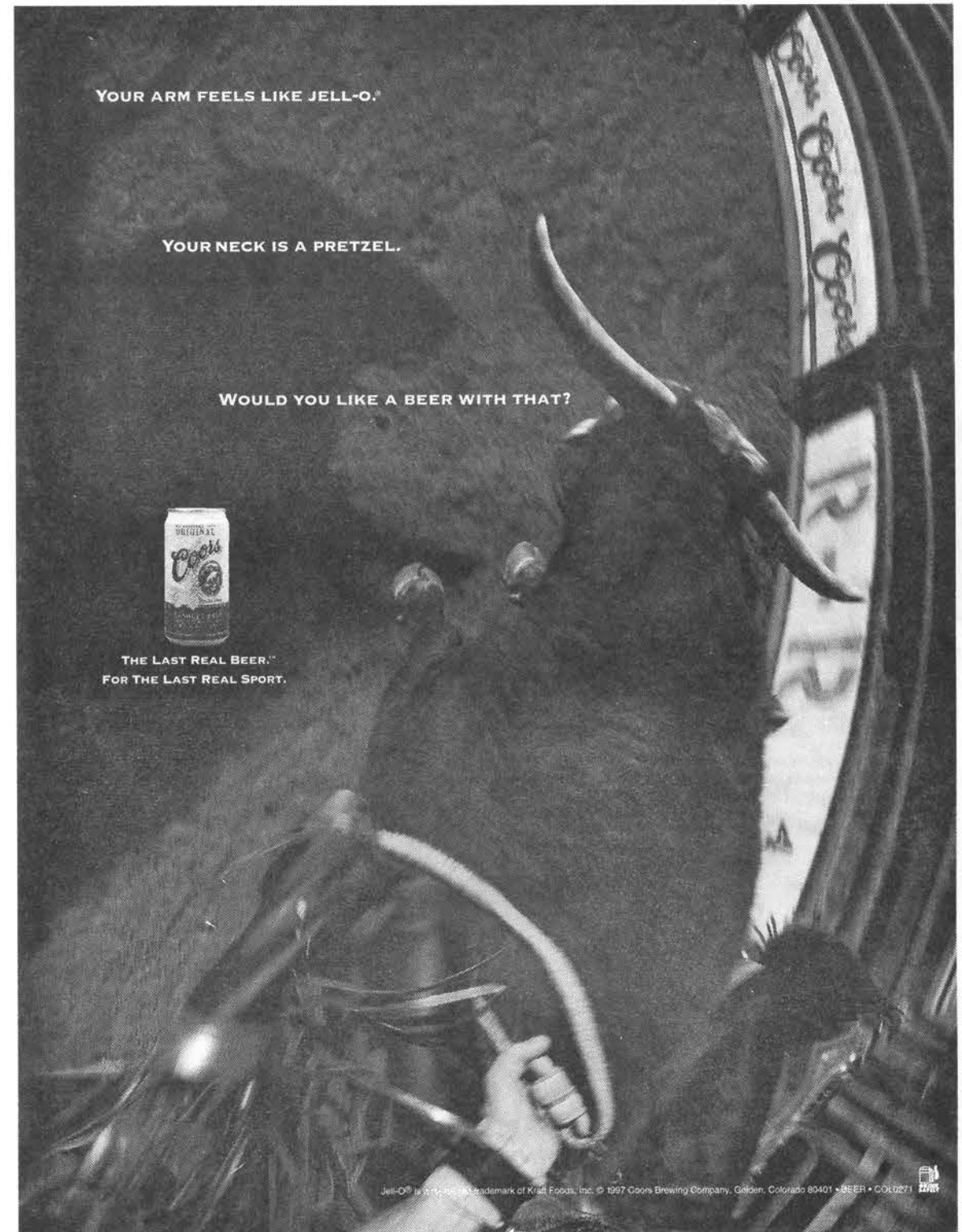
This dinner meeting allows the NRA stock contractors to meet our local Montana Coors Distributor and review the past year's program.

MontanaFair Named 1997 Rodeo of Year

MontanaFair SO MUCH appreciates the Rodeo of the Year award.

Two years ago our staff agreed the MontanaFair rodeo had become pretty 'ho hum'. We felt the need for change.

Our staff and management has a "big picture" mentality and we decided there would be no sacred cows. Quite honestly, we looked at everything, including the use of a different Association. To the N.R.A.'s credit we determined we had the right organization. We just needed to freshen up.

We have some quality rodeo events in our building. It would probably come as a surprise that every one of them work with a bigger budget for their rodeo than MontanaFair. On one hand they are our competition. On the other, they are our customer and we do everything we can to help each of them improve and become more successful. There are not many facilities or communities that have four or five major rodeos in their arena every year and still keep all of them successful.

Thanks to cooperation from our stock contractor, Newman Rodeo Company, we went

against the grain of what the trend in rodeos has been lately. We shared costs and hired a specialty act. Not just any act—but the best in the country. The "One Armed Bandit" received three standing ovations.

We went to our hockey team and, with their computer program, we designed our own music based somewhat on what they do. We went to "Rock" music supplemented by "County Western". Though we had one of the top rodeo announcers in the region, we tried a change there, as well. This was in no way due to any weakness on his part but only to make a change for the sake of change.

We improved conditions for the rodeo secretary and dedicated a tram to run contestants and their equipment back and forth to the backside. We've tried to make the Opening Pageant new and different each year... something no one else had... and that is not an easy task.

Again, thanks so much to all of you who voted for us and all of you that compete in or help out at N.R.A. MontanaFair Rodeo.

Office Updates

Contestants:

Don't miss this one! Important new change for the 1998 season affects you!

Rule M.1.10.1. All individuals must purchase their card through the NRA office before they can enter a rodeo. The application must be signed, witnessed or notarized and have correct amount of money submitted or it will be refused. **The application must reach the NRA office 5 (five) days before entries are taken.**

And, if you or someone you know was placed on the NRA's ineligible list for a turn-out prior to 1992, you have now been granted amnesty! The Board voted at their fall meeting to clear all fines (except NSF checks) prior to 1992.

During the February board meeting, the Board voted that:

Slack may be used as a first preference when entering an NRA rodeo, however, performances must be filled before any slack preference is recognized. All slacks are if necessary.

Timed Event Horses of the Year

Calf Roping:

Not only did Cisco, Bert Vermandel's calf horse get Bert to the NRA Finals, Cisco help other calf ropers win money too. This NRA Calf Roping Horse of the Year was ridden by Travis Caldwell, Gary Woodworth, Chris Witcher, and Bill Boyce throughout the rodeo season. Cisco, now 14, help Bert rope a calf in 8.1 at the NILE and 10.1 at the NRA rodeo in Forsyth.

Bert bought Cisco from Vern McKinney as a 4-year-old and broke him to ride, heeled on him for 2 years and then started calf roping on him.

"He always had a good disposition, he is very willing, very athletic and never had any buck in him," says Bert. "I cowboied on him and he never, ever stumbled; he's very durable."

"Cisco is quick across the line and was a natural at working the rope," says Bert "and he is good around kids."

Bert will be hauling Cisco and his family to rodeos in the coming year.

Team Roping: Heading

Jetarky, better known as "Jet" has won NRA Heading Horse of the Year for the second time.

Sam Bird has owned this 15-year-old horse for 8 years and uses him any time he wants to rope something! "He's tough, he can take it," says Sam.

Sam is a successful header because "Jet scores good, faces good, runs hard and does the same thing every time," says Sam. "He gives it his 'all' every time."

It is no accident this horse is good: He is very well bred with Jet Deck and Leo Bar in his background.

"He is not real gentle," says Sam, "he gets humpy and will buck when you first saddle him if you're not careful."

Rumor has it that Sam practices singing for Karaoke while warming up Jet. Maybe that's why Jet is humpy?! But that is yet another story.

Breakaway Roping:

For the second year in a row, Jody Petersen's horse, Peppy, has been chosen NRA Breakaway Horse of the Year. Jody won this year's NRA championship roping on the 12-year-old gelding. He was Horse of the Year in the Southwest Region of the NIRA in 1995 and was chosen Runner-up Horse of the Year for the NIRA nation in 1996.

When this Peppy San Badger sorrel was a rookie, Jody roped a calf in 1.5 seconds at a Helena jackpot.

"He's a good horse, works good, scores good, and breaks and runs hard; but he bucked with me again the other day in practice," says Jody. "He is the horse that bucked me off and dislocated my left shoulder."

"You can run 10 jillion cattle on him and he never acts up in the box and runs hard every

time," says Jody.

To prove that he stops hard, Jody roped a calf in 2.5 at the Broken Horn Stampede and he fell down attempting a quick stop. The pair were clocked at 2.1 in Lewistown at the Central Montana Fair.

Barrel Racing:

Both Lynda Ottun and her daughter Jamie qualified for the NRA Finals on Classy, a 12-year-old gelding who is the NRA Barrel Racing Horse of the Year.

Lynda's dad, the late John Harstad, bought Easy Saint as a yearling and he is the sire of First in the class who the Ottun's call "Classy." Jon and Lynda bought Classy as a 4-year-old from her father's estate.

"Classy had been on the race track and was race-track broke, until Tiny trained him on barrels." Says Lynda. "He wants to run and turn if I ride him right, he is pretty much automatic. He has made several 17.0 and 17.1 runs on regulation patterns. Tiny won several futurities on him as a 5-year-old and (daughter) Joeleen also ran him over Labor Day this year."

"He has a lot of heart. One year Classy had a lung infection and the vet said he could not believe he was running so tough. He figured I had a 50 percent horse."

This horse with the big heart will be seen competing for the Ottun family again this upcoming rodeo season.

Steer Wrestling:

Smokin' Joe, second time NRA Steer Wrestling Horse of the Year, achieved a difficult accomplishment: He carried two Garrison brothers to two year-end championships in 1997. Jim Garrison won the NRA Steer Wrestling championship on Smokin' Joe and Tim Garrison won the Montana Circuit Steer Wrestling championship.

This good black horse extended the career of the owner, Jeff Solomon who has been one of Montana's most consistent bull doggers.

"Joe" has competed at all levels of rodeo: With the Solomon teenagers in high school rodeo on up with Jeff placing in the first round at the Calgary Stampede.

"I was 2.4 once," says Jeff, "but that was in my dreams only."

At the NRA Finals, Joe carried steer wrestlers to a total of \$3,300. This 12-year-old gelding is not crowing about this great feat; he is just happy to be back home in the pen with his best buddy, Blackie, the hazing horse.

Jeff and Sue Solomon have owned both horses for 6 years and keep them by loading them in the trailer the same way.

"Joe has paid for himself several times," says Sue, "He is well worth having around."

Joe was raised by Philip Beaumont of Pryor.

Discussion concerning evaluation of stock contractors. All stock contractors will be evaluated every year at fall Board of Directors meeting.

Discussion concerning Central Entry. Sharon Martin updated board on Big Sky Central Entry's new entry system.

Discussion on stock contractors bidding rodeos: *It was moved and seconded: add rule A.2.21. If stock contractor declines existing rodeo or cannot come to terms with existing rodeo committee this will open bidding to all NRA approved stock contractors. Unreasonable terms to be determined by advisory board. Passed.*

Discussion on Committee meetings. Ray McGowan & Rodger Nordahl updated Board on committee meetings.

Discussion concerning ineligibility. *It was moved and seconded: amend rule D.10.0.: Turnouts: Turnout fine will match the entry fee and all additional charges (stock charge, central entry charge, judges charge, etc.) Ineligibility: violators will be ineligible to enter in NRA rodeos effective five (5) business days from the date of the last performance which turn-out occurred and will not regain eligibility until such time as fees and fine are paid in full. Passed.*

Discussion on using Visa and /or MasterCard for purchasing membership. *It was moved and seconded: add a rule M.2.1.6. Members are allowed to use Visa and/or MasterCard for purchasing memberships. A \$5.00 processing fee will be charged for each Visa and/or MasterCard use. Passed.*

Discussion concerning using slack as a first preference. *It was moved and seconded: amend rule A.4.3. Slack may be used as a first preference when entering an NRA rodeo, however, performances must be filled before any slack preference is recognized. All slacks are as necessary. Passed.*

Discussion concerning team roping steer wrestling cattle. *It was moved and seconded: amend rule R.11.13. Cattle used for steer wrestling shall not be used for team roping unless approved by stock contractor and steer wrestling and/or team roping director. Passed.*

Discussion concerning stock draw at call backs.

Discussion concerning finals timed-event livestock. *It was moved and seconded: amend rule F.5.6. NRA stock contractors will be given the first opportunity to bring timed-event livestock to the NRA Finals. Director has final right of refusal 45 days prior to the first performance of the NRA Finals. Passed.*

Discussion concerning entries for NRA Finals.

Discussion concerning NRA Finals bucking stock. *It was moved and seconded: add a rule F.5.7. If animal does not perform in rough stock events during the NRA Finals to judges discretion there will be no payment made on that animal. Passed.*

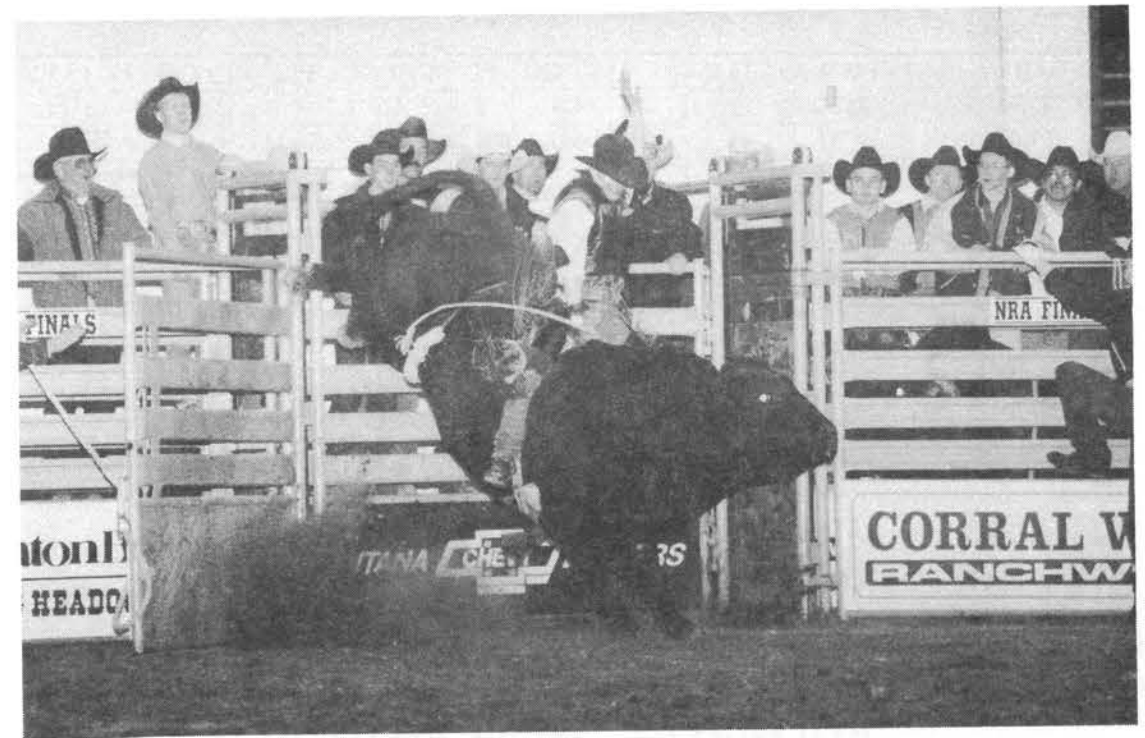

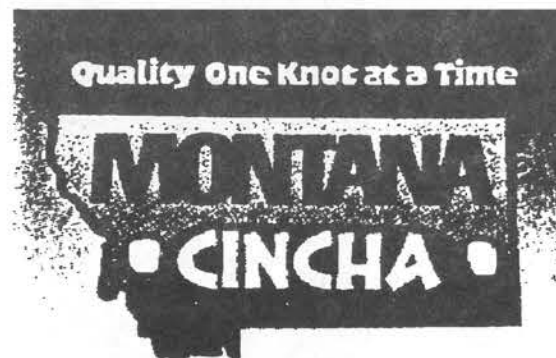
