


ffice Updates!

Doctor and Vet Releases: Now here is trouble spot! In accordance with rule A.5.16, "A doctor's release or vet's release must be sent into the Association office within five days after the day of the rodeo to be an excused no show..." Translation and emphasis on the WITHIN FIVE DAYS portion, please! A \$10 per rodeo charge is also assessed. For your benefit and convenience, the NRA Office is equipped with a fax machine (dedicated 24 hour line, too) and a VISA/MASTERCARD zon. We make it easy for you! So help us by getting those releases in here within the proper time frame.

Things to remember: New NSF Fine is \$100 per check...

Remember: We have voice mail at the NRA Office. It picks up automatically if both phone lines are busy. It also picks up after the fifth ring if we are away. If you reach voice mail, please leave a message, we'll get right back to you!

Good job, contestants for your professionalism on handling your trades through the NRA office. In addition to keeping us posted if you are a notified turnout or medical or vet release prior to the actual rodeo. Everyone involved appreciates knowing that you are not going to be there. As we move into fairtime rodeos, keep up the good work!

Brandi Beecher of Cohagen received from Jeanne Carpenter a subscription to The Cowboy's Digest for fourth place.




The \$100 purse was donated by J.C. Tire of Columbus.

PERMITS: Entitles purchaser to work all sanctioned rodeos accepting permits as listed in newsletter untio \$500 is won. After \$500 money limit is won by permit holder, a card must be purchased, the price of card to be the dollar difference between the cost of a permit and the cost of the card. Permit holder's points will be credited to the year-end standing, however, the contestant must be a card holder to compete at the NRA Finals. The \$500 money limit will be accumulated from year to year, allowing the contestant to purchase a permit each year until the \$500 is won. A card holder the previous year cannot purchase a permit the following year.

A CONTESTANT COMPETING IN BOTH ADULT AND JUNIOR EVENTS MUST HOLD BOTH A JUNIOR AND ADULT MEMBERSHIP

Both sides of application must be empleted to quarantee processing of membership application.

RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE

In consideration of being allowed to participate in Northern Rodeo Association sanctioned events and membership in the Association, I and my heirs, successors, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE and agree to HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the Northern Rodeo Association, the rodeo committees, stock contractors, sponsors, arena operations or owners, their agents, representatives (collectively referred to as the NRA) from all liability to me and my personal representatives, heirs, successors, and next of kin from and all claims and liability for all loss of damage, and any claim of damages therefore on account of any injury to my person including death or damage to my property while I am utilizing NRA facilities or participating in NRA events.

I, hereby represent to the NRA that I understand that THERE ARE CERTAIN RISKS OF SERIOUS INJURY AND DEATH inherent in participating in rodeo events and any related activities. I realize conditions of the rodeo arena change from time to time and may become more hazardous, that rodeo animals are dangerous and unpredictable and there is INHERENT DANGER in rodeo which I appreciate and voluntarily assume because I choose to participate in such events. I make this choice even though I have observed or participated in events of this kind in the past and know conditions, facilities, rodeo animals, and other rodeo contestants and participants pose a danger to me. I recognize and expressly agree to assume the entire risk of any and all accidents or personal injury including serious paralysis or death which I might suffer during my participation in said events.

I further COVENANT AND AGREE NOT TO SUE THE NRA for any injury, damages or death which occur as a result of my participation in said events and any claim or damage therefore. I understand that this document maybe treated as a complete defense to any legal action I might bring against the NRA for any injuries or other damages I might suffer.

I understand and agree this RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE extends to any and all claims I may have, specially including but not limited to, claims arising out of participation in said events, claims with respect to the design, manufacture, repair, or maintenance of the facilities or equipment which I will be using, or with respect to the conditions, qualification, instructions, rules or procedures under which my use of said facilities or equipment are conducted or from any other cause.

I UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THIS RELEASE AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE extends to ACCIDENT. INJURY. OR DEATH OCCURRING DURING THE TERM OF MY MEMBERSHIP IN THE NRA. Any subsequent Releases and agreement I might sign in the future shall amplify, but shall in no way limit, the provisions of this document.

I further state and certify that I have carefully read the foregoing Release, know the contents thereof and sign this Release and Agreement Not to Sue as a free and voluntary act. I am not relying on any statements of representations of any party released hereby. I UNDERSTAND THIS IS A RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS.



Drawouts, Tradeouts and Turnouts

The NRA Guidelines: for complete information, please refer to the NRA rulebook section A.8.0. The following is provided for your convenience.

DrawOuts: At the time of call back, a contestant may draw out of a rodeo(s). There is not a charge IF you did not receive your preference of performances. However, rule A.4.1.4 states: "Any contestant who draws out of a rodeo after receiving their first preference of performance at a given rodeo or rodeos will be fined \$20 per infraction."

TradeOuts: All NRA rodeos are trade-out rodeos unless advertised in the rodeo listing as "No Tradeouts".

A contestants may trade positions/performances of competition with another contestant at anytime after entries close, provided it is before the stock draw for that event.

If a trade is completed before callbacks close, trades are handled through central entry and may continue to be handled up until 10 a.m. the day following callbacks.

After 10 a.m. the day after callbacks, all trades are handled through the NRA Office 406-252-1122. Both parties involved in a trade must call the NRA office and confirm the trade.

Trades can be made at the rodeo upon consent of both parties involved before the draw in that event. Both judges and rodeo secretary must be nofitifed of trade by both parties. NOTE: The timed-event draw must be made in the presence of the rodeo secretary and can be made a minimum of two hours before the performance. We bring this to your attention so contestants plan to make trades earlier.

TurnOuts: As stated in the rulebook, if a contestant turns out at a rodeo, the fine will be equal to the entry fees. The NRA has rules which can soften the blow of an expensive turnout:

- 1. Notified turnout: If you know before 3 p.m. the last working day before the first perofinrance of a rodeo that you will not be competing at this rodeo, call the NRA Office. You will be responsible for your entryfees plus a \$20 fine. The fine is \$20 (plus all entry fees) no matter how many events you are entered in.
- 2. If it is too late to notify the NRA Office, you can find someone who will pay your fees at the rodeo for you and notify the secretary, judges, and contractor that you will not be there, your fine is half your entry fee (plus the payment of your fees at the rodeo).

Courtesy, please. Contractors, judges, secretaries, spectators, announcers, and fellow contestants appreciate knowing if you will not be there, thus an animal will not be drawn and this

How to enter NRA Rodeon

Welcome to the Northern Rodeo Association. NRA rodeos have utilized Big Sky Rodeo Central Entry since 1984 and offer the following guidelines to assist you. Take a moment to familiarize yourself with the NRA's rules on Central Entry. They can be found in section A.4.0 in the rulebook. A thorough knowledge of the NRA rules which apply to entering will help you better achieve your entry objective.

NRA Rodeo entry procedure through Big Sky Rodeo Central Entry • 406-428-2205

UNLESS OTHERWISE ADVERTISED, rodeo entries will open at 10 a.m. and remain open through 6:30 p.m. every Monday preceding a rodeo weekend. Call backs open at 12 Noon and remain open through 6:30 p.m. every Tuesday. Per rodeo charge of \$3.50 per contestant. Please read your rodeo listings carefully as the entry dates that fall on days other than the Monday before the rodeo will be in bold lettering.

When entering, be prepared with the following information for the central entry operator:

- 1. Name of rodeo(s) you wish to enter
- 2. Your NRA card number
- 3. Your name
- 4. The event (s) you wish to enter
- 5. Preferences you have on which performances you wish to work.
- 6. Name of buddy or buddies NRA rules allow for two per event, six total.
- 7. If a multi-rodeo weekend, give informatino for each rodeo you wish to enter.
- 8. Call back Tuesday between 12 Noon and 6:30 p.m. (unless otherwise advertised) to find out when you are up.
- 9. Keep a record of the confirmation number the central entry operator gives you, both upon entering the rodeo, and when you call back. Every conversation, both entry and call back, is recorded on tape, and each person calling is given a verification number for that conversation.

In the event of a discrepancy, you MUST have your confirmation number available. No complaints against Central Entry will be considered valid unless a confirmation number is given.

If you do not call back during the specified call back times, late call backs will be accepted at the late call back number 406-428-2398. There is an additional charge of \$2.50 per rodeo for this service.

WHEN NOTIFYING OF A TURN-OUT, CALL THE NRA OFFICE AT 406-252-1122. DO NOT CALL CENTRAL ENTRY.



Medical and Vet Releases: As soon as you are aware that you will be unable to compete at an NRA rodeo you have entered due to a medical or vet release, contact the NRA office. With a medical or vet release you are not responsible for your fees but releases must be sent into the NRA office within five days after the rodeo along with a \$10 processsing charge per rodeo.

Vet releases are accepted in the barrel racing event only. Keep in mind, when you medical or vet release, there is a five day waiting period before you can participate in another NRA rodeo.




